# LITURGY CORNER

Happy Easter! We rejoice today in the Resurrection of our Lord. As Christians, we believe that Jesus Christ is the Son

of God. He is one part of the Trinity. Jesus proved His divinity by conquering death through rising from the dead. Many people today look at Jesus and question His divinity. They call Him a "great teacher" or even deny His existence and think He's a fairy tale. Jesus' existence was real. He's a person proven to have existed through the historical accounts of non-Christian historians (see the writings of the Roman historians Josephus and Tacitus). Further, he's truly the Son of God. As opposed to other religious leaders who pointed elsewhere for salvation – Mohammed, Buddha, Confucius, etc., Jesus pointed to Himself as the key to salvation:

I am the way, and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father. (John 14:6-7)

Jesus invites us to gain access to the Father through a relationship with Him, the Son. Jesus can be that friend who's there with us to celebrate the good times in our lives and to carry us through the bad times. We enter into relationship with Him through prayer and through the Eucharist. We can't get any closer to Jesus than by receiving His body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist when we attend Mass. Jesus tells us:

Amen, Amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. (John 6:53-54)

Jesus has given us the gift of the Eucharist in order to draw closer to Him and to give us the opportunity for eternal life. We gain access to the Eucharist through the celebration of the Mass. It is important, therefore, that as Catholic Christians, we take advantage of the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist, through attendance at Mass, as often as we can. Happy Easter! Rejoice for the Lord has risen!



### In 1936 Our Lord said to St. Faustina...

"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy.

contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." (Diary of St. Faustina #699)
