

Dear Friends,

Happy Easter! I pray that this season in which we celebrate Jesus' Resurrection—his triumph over sin and death—brings you and your loved ones peace and joy. Here's some good news for this week:

- **Remember Mom.** Happy Mother's Day to all parish mothers, and to all our parishioners' mothers, living and deceased. We pray for all of you! If she's living, call your mom!
- **Pray for Our First Communicants.** This Saturday (May 8) and next (May 15), our second graders, who made their First Confessions during Lent, will receive our Eucharistic Lord in their First Holy Communion: may they be the first of many fruitful Communion! Please pray that our children and their families may persevere in faithfulness to the Most Blessed Sacrament.

- **Pray The Rosary.** May is a month traditionally dedicated to Our Lady, so I encourage everyone to pray the great Marian prayer of the Rosary daily: it's a great way to meditate the central mysteries of Our Lord and of Our Lady. Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has asked everyone to pray the Rosary daily this month for an end to the Coronavirus around the world. - **Attend Sunday Mass in person at St. Charles.** I encourage parishioners to consider keeping the Lord's Day holy by attending Mass in person on Sundays. Of course, everyone has to determine what is best for them, but factor in that we are doing everything we can to worship safely, and there have been no documented cases of Covid-19 spread through the parish. In any event, we will keep livestreaming the 10:30am and 12:00 Noon (Spanish) Masses.
