- We also encourage you to invite anyone you may know who has fallen away from the practice of the faith, and anyone who is spiritually or materially marginalized.

PARISH RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)



Please note that the dispensation by Bishop Burbidge of the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation has been lifted as of **the weekend of June 26-27**. - We have returned to the pre-COVID status for Masses, meetings, and events at the parish: there are no occupancy limits, no social distancing requirements, and no required disinfecting or cleaning between events; during the liturgy, we have choirs, holy water, an offertory collection, and the sign of peace.
- Fully vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a face mask in church. Unvaccinated individuals are encouraged to continue wearing a face mask.


