PARISH UPDATE

On the Cover: As more and more people get vaccinated, we are seeing a deep desire in our parishioners to serve and give of themselves. Recently, we welcomed a vibrant, masked, and socially distanced group of parish volunteers preparing mailings for the return of our annual parish picnic and raffle. The parish picnic will be on August 15th, and we are returning the picnic to the parish campus. The annual picnic this year will include a celebration of the start of the new year, recognition of the volunteers who make parish life so meaningful, and Fr. Benson's 30th anniversary of ordination. More details will follow in the near future about this outdoor event (and how we will celebrate it during this unique year).

Congratulations to our young people being confirmed this Sunday! This is the first of three celebrations of the sacrament this year, following diocesan pandemic protocols for social distancing. We want to thank and congratulate our confirmation team, led by Rachel Shumar (our youth minister and confirmation coordinator), for the innovative use of digital tools, service opportunities, and more. We have much to be proud of and grateful for, as we celebrate the Spirit moving through the lives of our eighth graders and our parish.

Mass Times: Please note: As we did last year, we will continue with our current weekend Mass schedule through the summer (and not go to a separate summer schedule). We have Mass on Saturday at 4pm and Sunday at 8:30am, 11am, and 5:30pm.

Mass Attendance Trends and Overflow Seating in the Gym: We are seeing more and more people come back to Mass: while the general dispensation for attending Mass remains in effect, we know this reflects our parishioners' deep hunger for Eucharist and community. Our highest attended Masses are 4pm (Saturday) and 11am Sunday. We thank you again for taking care to maintain safety protocols (masks and social distancing) at all Masses, which has a big impact on making people feel safe coming back. For those who seek even more social distance, you might consider the 8:30am Mass and especially: 5:30pm Sunday evening. Also, we have been asked by parishioners to add overflow seating in the Gym for the Saturday 4pm Mass, in addition to our Sunday morning Masses. The gym is a great option as the church begins to fill, and also for those feel more comfortable with a bit more social distance.

ROSARY - SUNDAYS IN MAY

Beginning Sunday, May 2nd and throughout the month of May (which is dedicated to Mary), we are praying the rosary on Sundays at two times. Join us on Sunday mornings at 8am in the Church (before the 8:30am Mass). Additionally, we are resuming our pre-pandemic custom of praying the rosary after the 5:30pm Mass, in the chapel.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (ALTERNATE SATURDAYS)

A reminder: We are currently celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation every other Saturday at 11am in the Church. We will next have confessions on **Saturday, May 8th and 22nd.**

Church Teaching on Vaccines: Father Benson (along with Pope Francis and the U.S. and Ohio Bishops) is encouraging parishioners to be vaccinated. U.S. Bishops write that **receiving vaccines "ought to be understood as an act of charity toward the other members of our community."**

Because of the ways in which the vaccines were developed, and with the aim of forming our consciences and culture to promote respect for human life, the bishops ask us to receive the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines if we are given the opportunity to choose a vaccine. But recognizing that often individuals do not have a choice of which vaccine to receive, Bishop Kevin Rhoades, chairman of the USCCB Committee on Doctrine, notes that, "the Vatican has made it clear that all the COVID vaccines recognized as clinically safe and effective can be used in good conscience."

Thank you for being vaccinated, as a way of protecting yourself and your family, and also the most vulnerable during this time of worldwide suffering.





Hunger Awareness Distribution of Funds Report





When Saul arrived in Jerusalem he tried to join the disciples, but they were all afraid of him, not believing that he was a disciple.
