BULLETIN COLUMN

This weekend we celebrate the birthday of the Church, Pentecost. At the first Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples and empowered them to become powerful and fearless Preachers of the Good News. The same Holy Spirit is active in our Church today! We have welcomed almost 60 new families to our community since last Pentecost. This is a testament to you, our community members who, like the disciples, share the Good News with family and friends. We recognize our new parishioners this weekend and welcome them to our family. We are blessed by the gifts that they bring to our community.

When we share the Good News, we are continuing the mission of the Church. In the Gospel of John a few weeks ago, Jesus promised to send an advocate to remind the disciples of everything he taught them and to bring peace. The gifts of the Holy Spirit empower and strengthen us to carry out Jesus' command to love as he loved. This mission we have been given is not easy. Like the disciples, we may be uncertain, even afraid. But if we accept the Holy Spirit's guidance, we will be given the courage and guidance to do and say the right thing.

This weekend, we also celebrate Friendship Sunday instituted by our Pastor, Fr. Benson. We come together, Catholics and non-Catholics, to worship together. CHURCH AT HOME COMBINED COLLECTION

This weekend parishes in our diocese will participate in the combined collection for three major **CHURCH AT HOME** ministries. The Catholic Campaign for Human Development provides local diocesan and national support for groups of low-income persons to change their lives. The Catholic Communications Campaign supports the efforts of the Catholic Television Network of Youngstown (CTNT) and other national telecommunications services to help spread the Word of God. The Catholic University of America and Newman Campus Ministries continue the educational programs at the national university of our Catholic Church. Your generous support is greatly appreciated.



MISSION APPEAL

As part of the Diocesan Missionary Cooperation Plan, Rev. Dr. Peter Osuji, CSSp, will visit our Parish on June 11-12, 2022 to speak about the missionary work of the Church and in particular that of the Spiritans (officially Congregation of the Holy Spirit). Fr. Peter, is from Nigeria. He serves as a professor of health care ethics at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh. Duquesne was founded by the Spiritans in the 1800's and today stands as one of the leading Catholic universities in the United States.

This visit is part of a national program in which annually a representative of one of the missionary groups visits parishes of the Diocese to invite parishioners to share in the mission work of the universal Church. The Spiritans are an international community engaged in a wide range of missionary activity in over 60 countries throughout the world.

The Baptismal font is in need of repairs. The current materials have become badly stained and cracked and it is leaking into the lower level of the church. Help is on the way! First we must drain the font to allow it to dry out. This will take place on June 6th. Then on June 13th we will remove the old tiles and begin the replacement with new surfaces. The reconstruction period will last thru the end of June. Please bare with us during this 'fix it' phase.

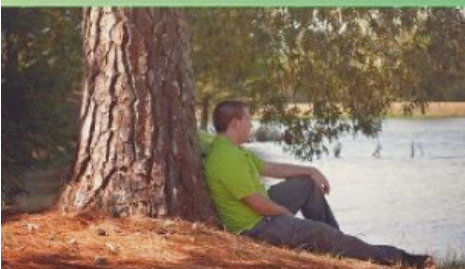

The Pending *Dobbs* Decision — How is a Catholic to Respond?

The leaked draft of the pending U.S. Supreme Court case of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* has returned the abortion debate to center stage in our already polarized culture.
