The reconstruction period will last thru the end of June. Please be patient with us during this 'fix it' phase.

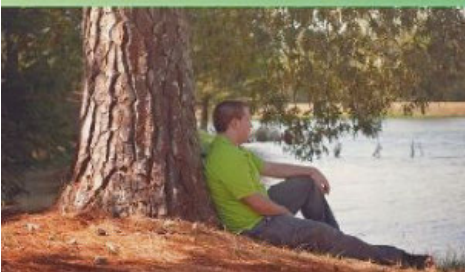

The Pending *Dobbs* Decision — *How is a Catholic to Respond?*

The leaked draft of the pending U.S. Supreme Court case of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* has returned the abortion debate to center stage in our already polarized culture.
