Sisters and Brothers,

You may notice a similar theme in the scripture this week; one of call and discipleship. We all have different responses when called to do something new or different. Some might hesitate, while others may jump in both feet first when called. Being called requires a level of openness to paying attention and listening to the Holy Spirit.

Fr. Connor Hetzel listened to the stirrings of the Holy Spirit when he answered the call to a vocation to the Priesthood. Fr. Hetzel was ordained last weekend in a beautiful Mass at St. Columba Cathedral in Youngstown. We are so grateful that Bishop Bonnar has appointed Fr. Hetzel as our new parochial vicar, effective July 1st. Let us continue to support him as he begins his priestly ministry in the Diocese of Youngstown and our parish community. We will formally welcome Fr. Hetzel with a reception after Masses July 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please join us!

With the addition of Fr. Hetzel, we will be reintroducing an 8 am weekday Mass effective July 5th. We will offer a 6:45 am Mass every morning and an 8 am Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings with a Liturgy of the Word with Communion Service at 8 am on Monday and Thursday. The current Thursday 6:45 am Liturgy of the Word with Communion Service will now be a Mass. Additionally, please join us for Mass on July 4<sup>th</sup> at 9 am in the Church.

You may have heard about the three-year Eucharistic Revival in the Church, an effort by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) to renew and rekindle a love for the Eucharist. Additionally, through diocesan and parish events, the revival hopes to increase Catholics' understanding of the Real Presence in the Eucharist. More information will be in next weekend's bulletin.

We have two upcoming events we are excited about. First, our annual Vacation Bible School will begin soon. Sign-up instructions are in the bulletin and on our website. 




