

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Brothers and Sisters,

The parable of the Good Samaritan is probably familiar to us, but have you ever placed yourself in the scene? Which character do you identify with? Why are you drawn to that particular character?

I think we all want to identify with the Samaritan traveler. The abandoned man was ignored and avoided by the priest and the Levite, but was offered unexpected compassion by a Samaritan. This merciful love was not shown by a religious leader, but by a Samaritan often considered to be the enemy of the Jewish people.

Imagine all the roles you have played in your life. Have you ever been the man beaten, and helped by a stranger? Have you been the Samaritan? Have you been the person who saw something, but kept walking?

We are called to love God and neighbor. For some, it might be easier to love God, than to love our neighbor. Living in a right relationship with another requires sharing love, mercy, and compassion. Families rely on the selfless love exemplified in this passage. Parents show love and care for their children not just when it's easy and convenient, but whenever their children's needs must be met. Imagine what it would be like if the members of a family were only concerned with their own needs. Things would probably fall apart quickly.

This Good Samaritan recognized the victim as his brother and accepted responsibility. He went out of his way to care for the needs of another. How do we take responsibility for another and care for the needs of another even when it is inconvenient? Who are the wounded travelers on your road? Are they travelers with a different skin color, language or religion?

We accept responsibility when we stop on the side of the road and help the wounded traveler. Today, that might be the family awaiting their Habitat house, or a child eager for new school supplies or a bag of food. May we look to those places outside our comfort zone to show God's merciful compassion.
