

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sisters and Brothers,

The story of Mary and Martha often evokes a lot of emotion. We can feel the frustration of Martha doing all the "work" while Mary spends time with Jesus. But Jesus reminds us that sometimes discipleship entails both meeting physical needs and being present with and for others and God. When we are attentive to Jesus, we can truly hear his voice and follow his invitation.

The Eucharistic Revival is a way for us to focus our attention on Jesus and renew our love of the Eucharist. As a parish family, we will offer a Eucharistic Procession on Saturday and Sunday, July 30th and 31st following the 4:00 pm and 11:00 am Masses. We will walk the procession through the surrounding neighborhood and re-enter the worship space for Benediction. We celebrate the presence of the Risen Christ in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist as we participate in this form of prayer.

When we are attentive to the needs of those around us we can respond with love and charity. Our annual school supply drive is coming up soon. The school supplies collected will go directly to those students who are most in need. The school supplies will help them feel dignified as they begin the year with all their materials. On a separate note, this summer we continue our upgrades around the campus. The refinishing of the baptismal font will be completed soon.
