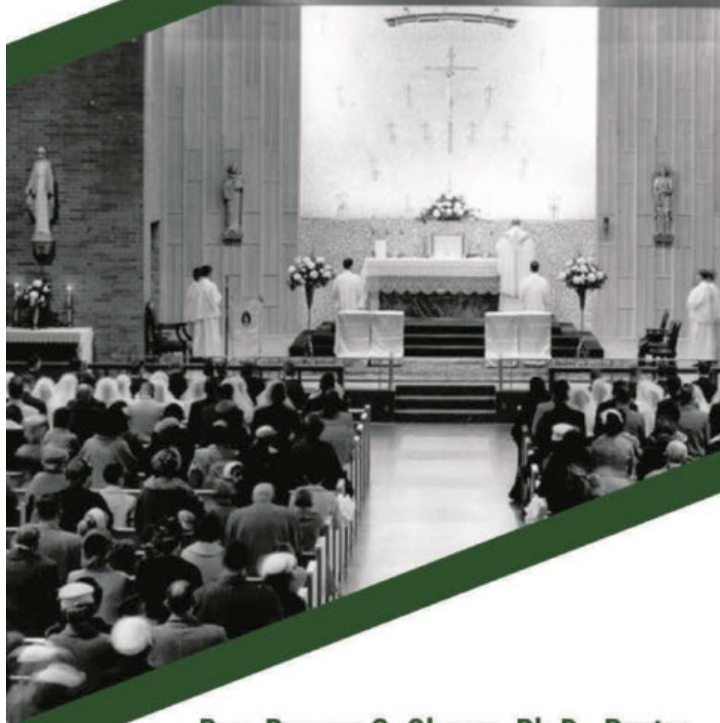

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My dear Brothers and Sisters,

We gather with grateful hearts this weekend as we begin the celebration of our 70th Anniversary as a Catholic Community. 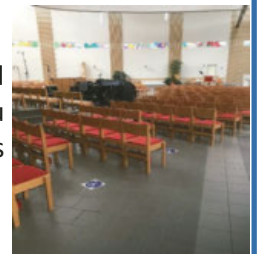
