It is good to be back home after an eleven day working vacation in the Diocese of Honolulu. As I write this I am preparing to leave for another three nights for the diocesan convocation of priests with Bishop Perez. The two parishes where I gave a stewardship retreat over the two weekends were in different parts of the island of Oahu. One was on the east side of the island and the other one was right across the street from the Aloha Stadium, near Pearl Harbor. Both are large parishes and we had about ninety people take part in the retreat in both parishes. I hope that we all use this time of Renewal as a way of growing closer to Christ.
