REGARDING LITURGICAL POSTURE FOR THE COMMUNION RITE:

On March 15, 2019, Bishop Perez issued a letter concerning the liturgical posture to be observed from the Communion Rite in the Diocese of Cleveland. The letter does not contain any new directives, but serves to reinforce directives which have already been promulgated in prior years, but which have not been completely implemented in some parishes.

His Excellency’s directives will require **NO CHANGE** for us here at St. Ignatius of Antioch, as we are up-to-date in implementing recent liturgical directives for the Communion Rite.

As a reminder the directives are as follows:

Stand after the Great Amen, and remain standing throughout the Lamb of God and through the celebrant’s reception of Holy Communion. Throughout the distribution of Holy Communion, **remain standing** for the Communion Hymn.

During the distribution of Holy Communion you may *sit or kneel* when necessary or for a period for personal prayer. But please stand once your personal prayer is concluded for the remainder of the Communion Hymn if you are able.

When the last person has received Communion (when the vessels have returned to the altar) you may **Sit or Kneel** for personal prayer. You do not need to remain standing during the purification of vessels.

“As High Priest responsible for divine worship in the particular Church, the Bishop has the task of ordering, promoting and safeguarding the entire liturgical life of the diocese (Apostolorum Successores 145)”. May Bishop Perez know the constant support of our prayers and obedience.
