FROM OUR PASTOR



As we celebrate this week our nation's Independence Day, we are reminded of the grave duty of Catholics to pray for our nation. Please join me in praying these beautiful petitions, composed for the inauguration of President George Washington by Archbishop John Carroll (whose brother, Charles Carroll was the only

Catholic signer of the Declaration of Independence).

"We pray Thee, O God of might, wisdom, and justice! Through Whom authority is rightly administered, laws are enacted, and judgment decreed, assist with Thy holy spirit of counsel and fortitude the President of the United States, that his administration may be conducted in righteousness, and be eminently useful to Thy people over whom he presides; by encouraging due respect for virtue and religion; by a faithful execution of the laws in justice and mercy; and by restraining vice and immorality.

Let the light of Thy divine wisdom direct the deliberations of Congress, and shine forth in all the proceedings and laws framed for our rule and government, so that they may tend to the preservation of peace, the promotion of national happiness, the increase of industry, sobriety, and useful knowledge; and may perpetuate to us the blessing of equal liberty.

We pray for all judges, magistrates, and other officers who are appointed to guard our political welfare, that they maybe enabled, by Thy powerful protection, to discharge the duties of their respective stations with honesty and ability.

We recommend likewise, to Thy unbounded mercy, all our brethren and fellow citizens throughout the United States, that they may be blessed in the knowledge and sanctified in the observance of Thy most holy law; that they may be preserved in union, and in that peace which the world cannot give; and after enjoying the blessings of this life, be admitted to those which are eternal."

As we gather for hotdogs and hamburgers and fireworks this week, let us be mindful of our great duty to use our freedom for the works of God, to strive for the treasure from heaven that endures eternally. May each of us being counted as good and faithful stewards of our American liberties, for the glory of God and salvation of souls. "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord" (Psalm 33).

Time, check. Talent, Check. Treasure, check. Our call to grow in gratitude and to respond by sharing goes far beyond these three aspects of our lives. We are called to recognize that all is blessing and to be good stewards of all of it. This is one of the greatest challenges of stewardship leadership. It is difficult to "get our arms around" all that being a good steward entails. It would be an overstatement to say that people will grow as stewards in direct proportion to the ways in which we continually invite them to grow in gratitude and respond as good stewards.
