**FROM OUR PASTOR**



This weekend we hear one of the most beloved of the Parables of Jesus: the Parable of the Good Samaritan. This Parable is one of the Lord's clearest instructions that his disciples are to be at the service of others. Consider what recent Popes have taught about this parable.

Pope St. John Paul II explained that "Christ, the Son of God, is the Good Samaritan par excellence. He is the Savior who finds humanity half-dead by the roadside and stops to heal our wounds. By his death on the Cross, he revealed 'the tender mercy of our God,' who desires that all men be saved. By his Resurrection, he restored us to life, to spiritual health. And in return he invites us to love others as he himself has loved us." Pope Benedict XVI continued this line of thought: "At the end of the parable, Jesus said: 'Go and do likewise.' With these words he is also addressing us. Jesus exhorts us to bend over the physical and mental wounds of so many of our brothers and sisters whom we meet on the highways of the world," he said. "He helps us to understand that with God's grace, accepted and lived out in our daily life, the experience of sickness and suffering can become a school of hope."

And of course, parable of the Good Samaritan has inspired much of the Pontificate of Pope Francis, who has famously said that the Church should be like a "field hospital after battle." Holy Father Pope Francis writes, "The Church's ministers must be merciful, take responsibility for the people and accompany them like the Good Samaritan, who washes, cleans and raises up his neighbor," he said. "This is pure Gospel. ... The ministers of the Gospel must be people who can warm the hearts of the people, who walk through the dark night with them, who know how to dialogue and to descend themselves into their people's night, into the darkness, but without getting lost."

"Go and do likewise," as Jesus put it. "Do this and you will live." For the glory of God and salvation of souls.
