FROM OUR PASTOR



"Honor, greetings and blessings to you, conquerors of the moon, pale lamp of our nights and our dreams," Pope Paul VI said in a message to the three Apollo 11 astronauts who had just landed on the moon, 50 years ago this weekend.

A few months later, the Holy Father had the opportunity to meet with Neil Armstrong, Michael Collins and Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin at the Vatican. Pope Paul told Armstrong that he was right on the mark in describing the mission as "one giant leap for mankind."

"Man has a natural urge to explore the unknown, to know the unknown; yet man has also a fear of the unknown," Pope Paul told the three men. "Your bravery has transcended this fear and through your intrepid adventure man has taken another step toward knowing more of the universe."

Paul VI and subsequent Popes have each taught that while technology could allow humanity to reach great heights, its use for good or evil always depends on human minds and hearts adhering to the precepts of authentic ethics.

"Modern technology places at our disposal unprecedented possibilities for good, for spreading the truth of our salvation in Jesus Christ and for fostering harmony and reconciliation," said Pope John Paul II. "Yet its misuse can do untold harm, giving rise to misunderstanding, prejudice and even conflict. When others are portrayed in hostile terms, seeds of conflict are sown which can all too easily escalate into violence, war or even genocide."

Pope Francis, too, has commented on the proper use of technology, urging scientists to channel their efforts into creating technology for the common good with the proper care for the environment in mind. Yet, not just scientists are called to the ethical use of technology: he has warned young people about wasting time on the Internet, and also publicly stated that he no longer watches television.

On this 50th anniversary of the moon landing, we consider our own call to courageously enter into the unknown when it is for the benefit of the common good and the spread of the Gospel, and seek to ensure that our use and promotion of technology is always in keeping with the authentic Christian morality for the glory of God and salvation of souls.
