FROM OUR PASTOR



Last weekend, I shared the news that on the First Fridays of each month, beginning **September 6 at 7pm**, we will have an hour of Eucharistic Adoration with devotions and benediction.

This hour of prayer comes as a result of our recent Parish Visioning Session. One parishioner shared how “spending an hour before the blessed Sacrament causes the stresses of the week to melt away.”

I mentioned that a recent Pew Report claims that less than one-third of Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ. The Catechism clearly articulates our ancient faith that “In the liturgy of the Mass we express our faith in the real presence of Christ under the species of bread and wine (CCC 1378).”

Additionally, Pope Paul VI after Vatican II reaffirmed the practice of adoring the Eucharist outside of Mass: “The Catholic Church has always offered and still offers to the sacrament of the Eucharist the cult of adoration, not only during Mass, but also outside of it, reserving the consecrated hosts with the utmost care, exposing them to the solemn veneration of the faithful, and carrying them in procession (Paul VI, *Mysterium Fidei*, 208).”

Pope Francis said recently, “Immersing oneself in silent Eucharistic adoration is the secret to knowing the Lord.”

So, invite everyone to come and spend time with the Lord. Acknowledge his presence, kneel in adoration, come to know him more deeply. Come and pray for those who lack faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. And pray for the Lord to shower blessings upon our parish.

“Moreover, I want to encourage everyone to visit – if possible, every day – especially amid life’s difficulties, the Blessed Sacrament of the infinite love of Christ and His mercy, preserved in our churches, and often abandoned, to speak filially with Him, to listen to Him in silence, and to peacefully entrust yourself to Him (Pope Francis).”

Thank you to the Legion of Mary who will be providing **wine, cheese, and refreshments**, following First Friday Holy Hours.
