“What did you do on your Summer Vacation?” I remember as a child, the first day of school often involved sharing a story from your summer vacation.

As many of you know, I was able to make pilgrimage this summer with Bishop Perez and 25 priests from the Diocese of Rome and Assisi. I’ve been asked by several people to share pictures and stories from my trip. So, for our first **Faith Formation** evening of the Fall (second Fridays of the month at 7pm in the School Cafeteria), I will be offering a presentation of my pilgrimage, with an explanation of the significance of the holy sites, and also give a teaching on the theology and spirituality of pilgrimage. “Pilgrimage”, after all, is a common theme in the Documents of Vatican II and part of our liturgical language.

As summer vacation comes to a close, and as the school year commences, please keep in your prayers the young people of our school and their families and our teachers and school staff. Though most of our student population are not Catholic, it is certainly part of the enduring mission of this parish to support Catholic education, and to witness to the truth of our faith to all by our words and deeds. **LEGION OF MARY**

The Legion of Mary is a Catholics lay apostolic association who, with the sanction of the Church and under the powerful leadership of Mary Immaculate, Mediatrix of All Graces, serve the Church and their neighbor on a voluntary basis in about 170 countries.



In the last month, members of our parish’s Legion of Mary contributed 46 hours of parish volunteer work, prayed 93 novena and chaplet prayers, spent 16 hours visiting patients in hospitals and nursing homes, engaged in 173 acts of faith formation, made 12 visits to the homebound, said 264 5-decade rosaries and 10 15-decade rosaries, had 24

instances of elder care, 3 instances of eucharistic adoration, sent 21 cards of sympathy, gave 72 pieces of religious literature, lifted up 240 personal prayers, committed 106 acts of kindness, attended 65 weekday masses, and 4 wakes and funerals.
