**PASTOR'S COLUMN**

Each year during Lent for the past decade, the parishes of the diocese have held an *Evening of Confessions* where every parish had priests available for the Sacrament of Confession for three hours. I have heard beautiful confessions on those evenings, some Catholic returning to the Sacraments after 20, 30, 40, or 56 years. Many Catholics make their annual confession on that evening.



Due to COVID-19, the diocesan-wide event was cancelled this year, though the bishop encouraged each parish to consider how they might make the Sacrament available. **This Wednesday, March 24, from 5 pm to 8 pm**, Confessions will be offered here in the Church. While I would hope each of you feel comfortable coming to me, your pastor for confession, we will also have a guest confessor to assist on Wednesday evening. Please take the time to make a thorough examination of conscience using the booklet in this week's bulletin.

Catholics are *obligated* to make a sacramental confession if and when they commit a sin of a serious nature. All Catholics are *encouraged* to make sacramental confessions throughout the year, especially in the seasons of Lent and Advent—seasons in which we acknowledge and do penance for our sins and those of the world.

Pope Francis has urged Catholics to return to Confession to make “the act of faith, of abandonment, with which the penitent approaches Mercy.” The Pope also emphasized the importance of frequent Confession as “a way of sanctification, a school of faith, of abandonment, of change and of correspondence to the Father's merciful Love.”

Don't be afraid of confession. Jesus is waiting for you there.

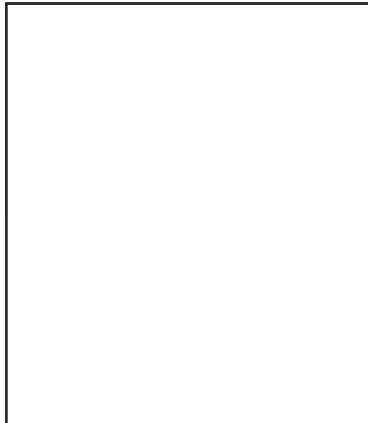
