PASTOR'S COLUMN

This time last year, we were entering into the holiest week of the year while in COVID lockdown. I'll never forget standing in the bitter cold handing out blessed palms in order to provide some concrete connection to the Church's sacred liturgical life. This year, we are still not able to have processions throughout the Church with the palms, but we are so glad to have returned to relative liturgical normalcy.

I hope you are able to join this week in the great liturgies of Holy Week, including Solemn Vespers at 7pm on Palm Sunday evening, and Solemn Morning Prayer at 9 am on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.

I highly recommend reading the Scripture Passages pertaining to Holy Week, especially the Passion Narratives, throughout the week. You will not regret turning off the television, setting down your mobile devices, and entering deeply into the Lord's final days and hours. Remember that all that he did, all that he suffered, he did and suffered out of love for you, for the forgiveness of your sins. Show your gratitude to Him by engaging in the Church's liturgies as much as possible this week. May you be blessed this week with a deep knowledge of the depths of the Lord's love, for the glory of God and salvation of souls.

On the Pious Use of Palms

Following Palm Sunday, you are encouraged to keep the blessed Palms in your homes or work places. The Palms may be kept throughout the year as a witness to faith in Jesus Christ, the messianic king, and in his Paschal Victory. Dried palms may be returned to the church in anticipation of Ash Wednesday next year or may be burned or buried.

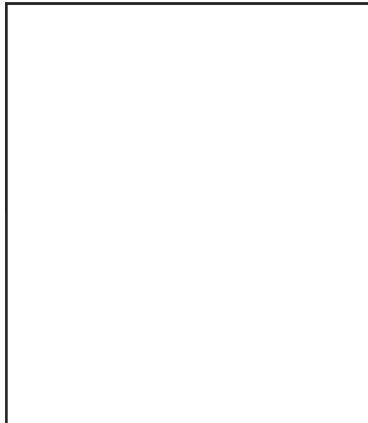
