PASTOR'S COLUMN

For much of the world, Easter is over and done with. For Catholics, we're just getting started. The 50-day Easter Season, or Eastertide,



continues to be celebrated until the Feast of Pentecost. The new Easter Candle, blessed and lit at the great Easter Vigil, continues to shine throughout the season reminding us of the time Christ spent with his disciples after his Resurrection, strengthening them in faith and preparing them for the mission of spreading the Gospel.

Easter is also more than just an extended celebration of the resurrection of Jesus, but a time of Christian formation. I will continue to meet with those who received the Easter Sacraments to reflect deeply on the Christian mystery and to discuss how the Christian faith is lived out in the world.

Easter is also a time of new life. Here at St. Ignatius we are excited for the garden club beginning their spring work, the food pantry and share-a-meal program starting up again after a short hiatus due to COVID, and a return to congregational singing at mass.

Note also, the changes to the liturgical schedule: confessions and Eucharistic Adoration will now be available every **Saturday from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm**, and a Sunday evening **Latin Mass in the Extraordinary Form will be offered each week at 6 pm starting next weekend Sunday, April 18.**

We also have some exciting summer social and fundraising events in the works, not to mention planning for our thrice-rescheduled Gala. Thank you again for your continued support as we, like the Easter Candle, seek to radiate with the light and love of Christ, to be instruments of the Gospel, for the building up of the Church, for the glory of God and salvation of souls.
