SPRING CONFIRMATION PREPARATION CLASSES

For Roman Catholics, the Sacrament of Confirmation is one of the three sacraments necessary for full initiation into the Church. Along with great graces and strengthening in the gifts of the Holy Spirit, with Confirmation comes the privilege of serving as a Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation sponsor.



Confirmation will be held on Sunday May 23, 2021, Pentecost Sunday at the 11am Mass.

Catholics 14 years and older who have been baptized AND have received first Communion are invited to prepare for the Sacrament (provided that there are no canonical impediments).

Three mandatory preparation session for Confirmation will be held on Monday, May 3, Monday, May 10, and Monday May 17 at 7pm in the school cafeteria. Parents/Guardians should attend sessions with children under the age of 18. Sponsors are encouraged to attend as well.

Please bring a newly issued copy of your Baptismal Certificate to the first session, and if you can, a fully-initiated Catholic in good standing in the Church to serve as your sponsor. Please register ahead by calling the rectory office or emailing fr.kevin.estabrook@gmail.com.

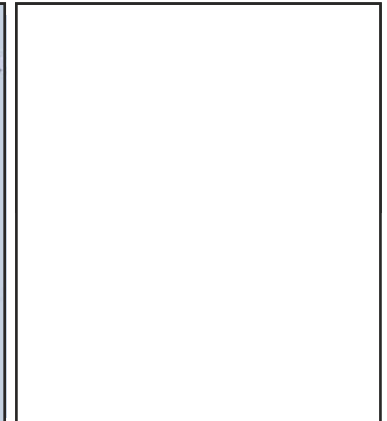
