PASTOR COLUMN

9 years ago, Pope Benedict XVI authorized a decree for the canonization, beatification, and recognition of the heroic virtues of several holy souls. One was Father Giuseppe Puglisi, a Sicilian Priest who was killed by the Sicilian Mafia in 1993. He was gunned down on the steps of his church for condemning organized crime and trying to rally his flock to take a stand against evil in his community. He is being recognized as a martyr.

The Holy Father also issued a decree for the beatification of 158 men and women who were martyred during the Spanish Civil War between the years 1936 and 1939 for opposing fascist and anti-Catholic dictatorship in their country. Thousands of lay people, priests, and nuns were martyred for opposing the anti-Catholic fascism in the 20th century.

The Holy Father has also decreed that an American be recognized as venerable. Many of you have definitely heard of this holy archbishop, author, and radio and television evangelist, who is now known as Venerable Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen. Millions of people heard him on radio, watched him on television, and attended his many lectures on the Catholic faith.

I thought of Archbishop Sheen as I read today's second reading: As you excel in every respect, in faith, discourse, knowledge, and all earnestness...may you excel in love." Archbishop Sheen surely excelled in faith, discourse, knowledge, and earnestness. He received simply the best education our Church could provide; he graduated from Theological School in Louvaine Belgium with the highest honors, and taught at Catholic University in Washington, and through his intellectual gifts made the faith intelligible to millions.

But his education isn't why he is on the road to beatification. Bishop excelled in Christ-like love. He had a heroic dedication to the poor and suffering. He often visited the leper colonies and passed out food to the homeless of Rochester, where he was Bishop. Love impelled him to share the Gospel with all.

Father Puglisi, the martyrs of the Spanish Civil War, and Archbishop Sheen remind us that our call to holiness involves allowing the Catholic Faith to permeate, animate, and direct our lives, allowing the love of Christ to change us and shape us, and to preach the Gospel in season and out of season for the glory of God and salvation of souls.

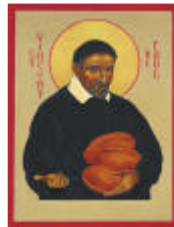
