PASTOR COLUMN

Coinciding with the Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus, Pope Francis has decreed that beginning this year, 2021, the fourth Sunday of July is a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. The theme for this first World Day is "I am with you always" (Matthew 28:20).



Today, youth and young families are encouraged to visit their grandparents and the elderly, especially those who are alone or homebound.

Grandparents are truly a gift to families and to the Church. A few years ago, on the Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, Pope Francis said, "How important grandparents are for family life, for passing on the human and religious heritage which is so essential for each and every society!" Elsewhere he said, "Grandparents are the living memory of family. They pass on the faith, they transmit the faith, to us."

Grandparents are in a very privileged position to plant and cultivate the most important seeds in a children's lives. We thank God for our grandparents living and deceased, and pray that they may continue to be a source of living faith for the Church.

A plenary indulgence can be obtained by participating in Mass on this occasion or by visiting an elderly person who is alone or in difficulty (and by fulfilling the usual conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer, according to the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff).
