As you may have heard, on tuesday, we received the news of the passing of Cleveland Bishop Emeritus Anthony Michael Pilla, 9th Bishop of Cleveland. His Episcopal Motto was “live on in my love”, taken from the words of our Lord at the last supper. Love, love for the church, love for Christians families, love for priests and religious, love for the poor, love of Christ and his Blessed Mother, love for all God’s people, not just Catholics, animated his episcopacy.

In Bishop Pilla, the Lord truly gave us an apostle whose life and priesthood and episcopacy were animated by love. What a great gift he was to the Diocese and to the Church. His Funeral will be on Tuesday at 11am at the Cathedral.

At each of the Masses this weekend, after Communion, we hear from a member of our parish chapter of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, which Bishop Pilla supported quite strongly. I urge you to consider the invitation to join and support this tremendous Society also animated by charity for the poor and needy.

In memory of dear Bishop Pilla, this week and all days, may we strive to live on and abide always in Christ’s love, for the glory of God and salvation of souls.
