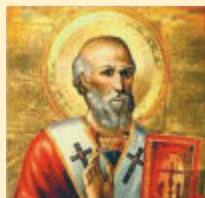

PASTORS COLUMN

In seminary one year, I remember hearing about how the early Church had such a tremendous esteem for St. Ignatius of Antioch, that his letters would often be read aloud during the Mass alongside the Scriptures. So, I decided to read through his letters myself, and they are a fascinating glimpse into the mind of a very holy and courageous bishop. Like St. Paul, Ignatius wrote letters to Christian communities like the Ephesians and Romans. And as Paul wrote to Timothy, who had become Bishop of Ephesus, Ignatius wrote to St. Polycarp, Bishop of Smyrna. Ignatius even seemed to model his writings after Paul, Peter, and John, and quoted from their works freely.



In the letters of Ignatius, we find eloquent teachings on the Eucharist, the primacy of the Bishop of Rome, the role of bishops, general in their local church, and the priesthood.

Consider these beautiful words the holy bishop writes to the Ephesians, encouraging Christians to gather together for prayer, particularly for the Eucharist: "Take heed, then, often to come together to give thanks to God, and show forth His praise. For when you assemble frequently in the same place, the powers of Satan are destroyed, and the destruction at which he aims is prevented by the unity of your faith. Nothing is more precious than peace, by which all war, both in heaven and earth, is brought to an end."

I wish a happy and blessed patronal feast day to you all. May the powerful intercession of the holy bishop and martyr, St. Ignatius of Antioch protect us and guide us in Christ, increase our faith, hope, and charity, and lead us to everlasting life.

Last weekend was the 35th Annual Blanket Sunday. But you can still make a donation if were unable to last weekend. The need is great and donations can be made securely online:

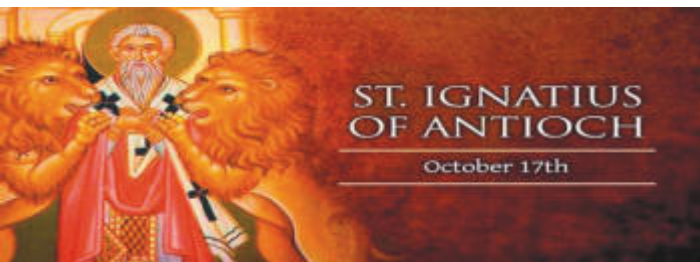
