PENTECOST SUNDAY

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Last week, I included in my bulletin column passages from the old Baltimore Catechism relevant to the feast of the Ascension. Here are some passages for your edification relevant to today's great feast of Pentecost.

94. Who is the Holy Spirit? The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity.

95. From whom does the Holy Spirit proceed? The Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son.

96. Is the Holy Spirit equal to the Father and the Son? The Holy Spirit is equal to the Father and the Son, being the same Lord and God as They are.

97. On what day did the Holy Spirit come down upon the Apostles? The Holy Spirit came down upon the Apostles ten days after the Ascension of our Lord, and the day on which He came down upon the Apostles is called Whitsunday, or Pentecost.
98. How did the Holy Spirit come down upon the Apostles?

The Holy Spirit came down upon the Apostles in the form of tongues of fire.

99. Who sent the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles? Our Lord Jesus Christ sent the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles.

100. Why did Christ send the Holy Spirit? Christ sent the Holy Spirit to sanctify His Church, to enlighten and strengthen the Apostles, and to enable them to preach the Gospel.

101. Will the Holy Spirit abide with the Church forever? The Holy Spirit will abide with the Church forever, and guide it in the way of holiness and truth.

The new Catechism of the Catholic Church also includes the following:

731. On the day of Pentecost when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given, and communicated as a divine person: of his fullness, Christ, the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance.

732. On that day, the Holy Trinity is fully revealed. Since that day, the Kingdom announced by Christ has been open to those who believe in him: in the humility of the flesh and in faith, they already share in the communion of the Holy Trinity. By his coming, which never ceases, the Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the "last days," the time of the Church, the Kingdom already inherited though not yet consummated.

We have seen the true Light, we have received the heavenly Spirit, we have found the true faith: we adore the indivisible Trinity, who has saved us. (Byzantine liturgy, Pentecost Vespers, Troparion, repeated after communion.)

ZELLIE'S HOME GOLF OUTING


