MOST HOLY TRINITY

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Continuing our theme over the past few weeks with relevant passages from the Baltimore Catechism (BC) and the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC), join with me in reflecting upon the following on this Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity:

BC 21. Is there but one God? Yes; there is but one God.

BC 22. Why can there be but one God? There can be but one God, because God, being supreme and infinite, cannot have an equal.

BC 23. How many Persons are there in God? In God there are three Divine Persons, really distinct, and equal in all things-the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost

BC 29. Are the three Divine Persons one and the same God? The three Divine Persons are one and the same God, having one and the same Divine nature.

CCC 234: "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the 'hierarchy of the truths of faith'. The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men 'and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin'.

CCC 253: "The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons, the 'consubstantial Trinity'. [Council of Constantinople II (553 AD)] The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire: 'The Father is that which the Son is, the Son that which the Father is, the Father and the Son that which the Holy Spirit is, i.e. by nature one God.' [Council of Toledo XI (675)] In the words of the Fourth Lateran Council (1215), 'Each of the persons is that supreme reality, viz., the divine substance, essence or nature.' [Lateran Council IV (1215)]"

CCC 254: "The divine persons are really distinct from one another. 'God is one but not solitary.' 'Father', 'Son', 'Holy Spirit' are not simply names designating modalities of the divine being, for they are really distinct from one another: 'He is not the Father who is the Son, nor is the Son he who is the Father, nor is the Holy Spirit he who is the Father or the Son.' [Council of Toledo XI (675)] They are distinct from one another in their relations of origin: 'It is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds.' [Lateran Council IV (1215)] The divine Unity is Triune."

Holy Trinity Sunday Collect: God our Father, who by sending into the world the Word of truth and the Spirit of sanctification made known to the human race your wondrous mystery, grant us, we pray, that in professing the true faith, we may acknowledge the Trinity of eternal glory and adore your Unity, powerful in majesty. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.
