# **PASTOR'S COLUMN**

Last Weekend on the 16th Sunday of Ordinary Time we heard the story of Abraham and Sarah receiving three guests and offering them hospitality. We also heard the account of the Lord Jesus' visit to the home of the Martha and Mary, who also offered him hospitality and listened to the Lord speak and teach. I mentioned in my homily that hospitality is a good a holy practice, that as society and community seem to be crumbling apart, Christians need to maintain—we need to invite, and feed, and listen in order to share the Word of God and receive the Word of God.

I also mentioned that I would like to visit your homes, to get to know you, to break bread with you. I really hope you take me up on this.

When a priest visits the home, it is customary that he blesses the home (including sprinkling the various rooms of the home with holy water), especially if the home has never been blessed by a priest since you moved in or if it's been more than a year since the blessing. Members of the household should all be present for the blessing, but also, it would be very appropriate to invite neighbors or extended family, especially if they are not practicing the faith. The house blessing (and subsequent meal) become an opportunity for renewing familiar and neighborly bonds and also reorienting those relationship to Christ the Lord. Please email or call me at the parish house to set up a house visit; we should have started this practice three and a half years ago!

In addition to the priest's blessing, here is a prayer you can offer from Saturday Compline (not a bad prayer to print out and place in your kitchen!).

Lord, we beg you to visit this house and banish from it all the deadly power of the enemy. May your holy angels dwell here to keep us in peace, and may your blessings be upon us always. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
