We would love to have you join our team!

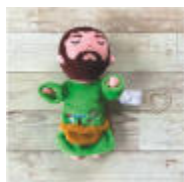
There can be no Nursery without attendants. It is possible that we will be available only on the first and third Sundays of the month if we do not have enough staff.

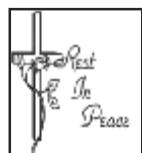
