I pray for you daily.

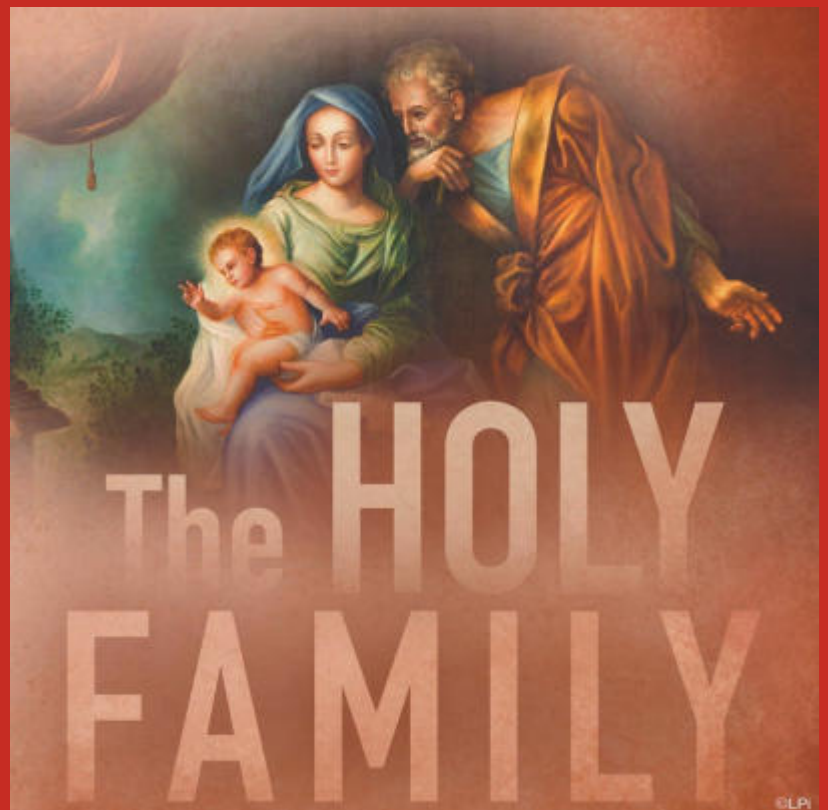

## Concerned About An Older Adult?

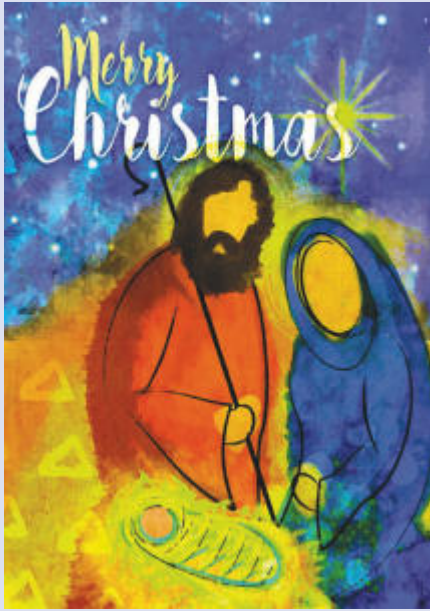

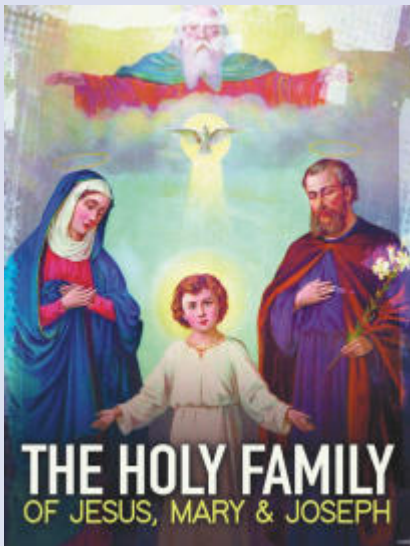

The Diocese now requires recertification training every 3 years on the original Protecting God's Children training. The training is a combined Protecting God's Children Maltreatment 3.2 and Vulnerable Adults Training.

You may have received an email notice from VIRTUS Online regarding recertification online training. VIRTUS is the brand name that identifies best practices programs designed to help prevent wrongdoing and promote "rightdoing" within religious organizations.

You need to go to Virtus.org and log in. Then click on the link that says "a training module has been assigned." The training takes about one and a half hours. Upon completion, please notify Safe

Environment Coordinator Georgene Natali so she can print your certificate for our file.

If the recertification is not completed, the individual will not be able to volunteer until recertification is completed.

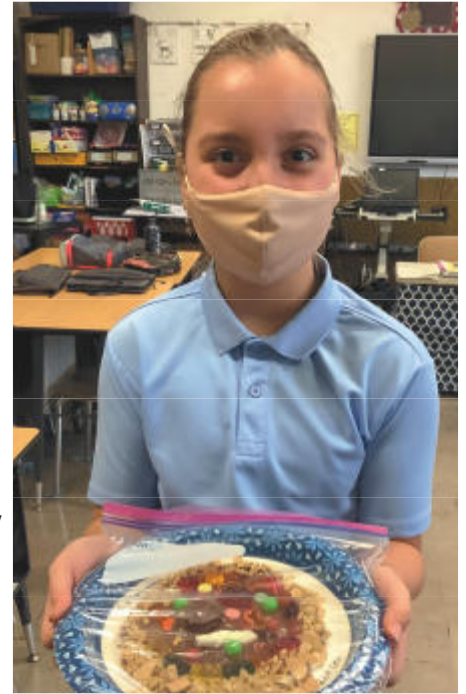

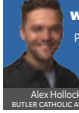

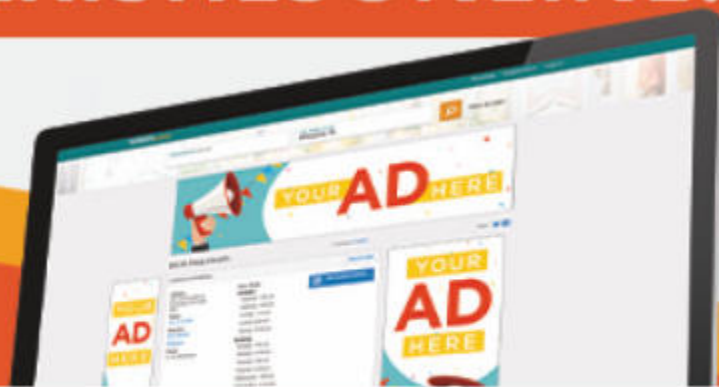
