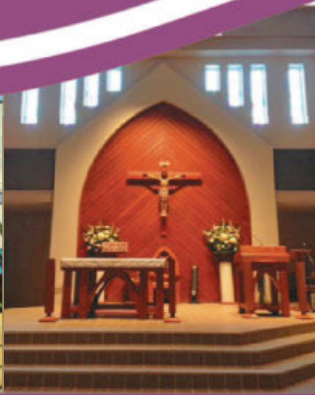
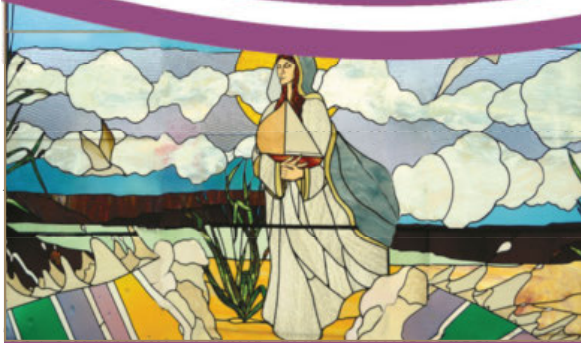

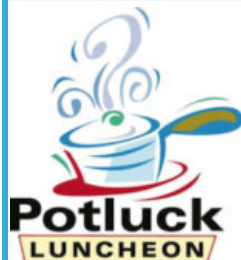

Let us keep on loving as Jesus did. Amen.

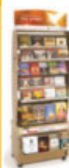

“The most powerful thing we can do on this earth with our time is to spend it in Eucharistic Adoration. Nothing can do more to change the world, to bring peace, to convert hearts, to make reparation for the many evils committed. Spending time in prayer may seem, on the outside, to be a passive thing; however, it is anything but! Our world is in desperate need of hope, of renewal, of a “turning back” to the things of God. By visiting Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, we take up the best weapon for the battles of our age and contribute to the healing of our culture.

Cultivating a Eucharistic life of adoration also bears tremendous fruit in our own hearts and lives. We cannot spend time in the rays of His Eucharistic Presence without receiving His grace, His love, His mercy, His peace. As we gaze upon Him Face-to-Face, we are transformed little by little into a closer reflection of His divine image.”

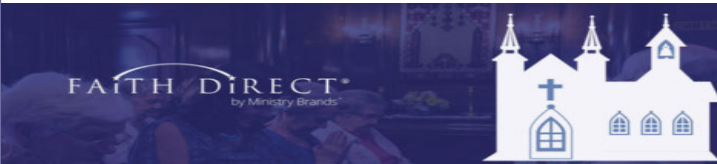

On May 16, 2022, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) offered the following statement in response to the recent shootings in Buffalo, NY and Laguna Woods, CA: "The U.S. bishops join with others throughout the country in offering prayers for the support and healing of the families, friends, and communities of those impacted by these violent incidents. We pray especially for those who were injured and particularly for those who lost their lives. We pray also for those on the front lines who risk their lives in responding to the calls for help, and to those in the medical fields who minister to those who have been harmed. The bishops again call for an honest dialogue rooted in Christ in addressing the persistent evil of racism in our country. The Catholic Church has been a consistent voice for rational yet effective forms of regulation of dangerous weapons, and the USCCB continues to advocate for an end to violence, and for the respect and dignity of all lives. We pray for and support the healing of the communities impacted and for all the victims of violence and that Christ's peace be upon all affected."

RESPECT LIFE: Life is precious from natural birth to natural death. Respect Life (<https://www.respectlife.org/>) promotes creating a culture in society that respects and protects all human life. Respect Life encompasses also need to advocate for life at all stages and challenges societal concerns of the current death and disposable culture of life, capital punishment/ death penalty, human trafficking, medical and mental health stigmas, suicide, euthanasia, cloning/reproductive technology, domestic violence, elder abuse, immigration biases, racism, poverty, and end of life concerns.

Please learn more about building a culture that promotes life and the integration of Christ's teachings of human dignity in our society. Recently on May 11, 2022, USCCB's Bishop Chairmen responded to Senate vote on Extreme Abortion on demand bill (S. 4132, Women's Health Protection Act). "This bill would have imposed abortion on demand nationwide at any stage of pregnancy through federal statute and would have eliminated pro-life laws at every level of government — including parental notification for minor girls, informed consent, and health or safety protections specific to abortion facilities. S. 4132 also would have compelled all Americans to support abortions here and abroad with their tax dollars and would have also likely forced health care providers and professionals to perform, assist in, and/or refer for abortion against their deeply-held beliefs, as well as forced employers and insurers to cover or pay for abortion. The 'Women's Health Protection Act' (S. 4132) is an utterly unjust and extreme measure that would impose abortion on demand nationwide at any stage of pregnancy through federal statute. We are relieved that the Senate vote to advance this bill failed for the second time in less than three months. This bill insists that elective abortion, including late-term elective abortion, is a 'human right' and 'women's health care' — something that should be promoted, funded, and celebrated. S. 4132 is far more extreme than Roe v. Wade. It would invalidate widely supported laws that protect women and unborn children from an unscrupulous abortion industry, would force all Americans to support abortion here and abroad with their tax dollars, and seeks to force religious hospitals and health care professionals to perform abortions against their beliefs."
