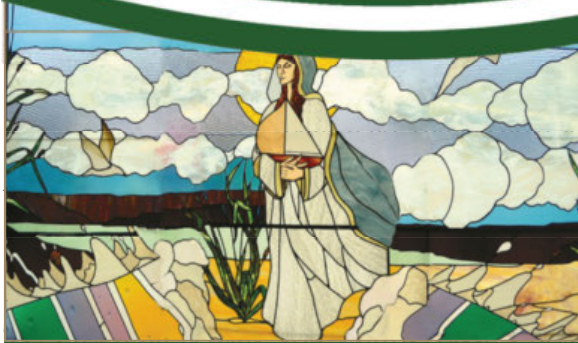

Receiving Our Lord at Mass in the Holy Eucharist is the closest we can come to Our Lord in this world. The next best thing is Eucharistic Adoration.

"The most powerful thing we can do on this earth with our time is to spend it in Eucharistic Adoration. Nothing can do more to change the world, to bring peace, to convert hearts, to make reparation for the many evils committed. Spending time in prayer may seem, on the outside, to be a passive thing; however, it is anything but! Our world is in desperate need of hope, of renewal, of a "turning back" to the things of God. By visiting Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, we take up the best weapon for the battles of our age and contribute to the healing of our culture.

Cultivating a Eucharistic life of adoration also bears tremendous fruit in our own hearts and lives. We cannot spend time in the rays of His Eucharistic Presence without receiving His grace, His love, His mercy, His peace. As we gaze upon Him Face-to-Face, we are transformed little by little into a closer reflection of His divine image."

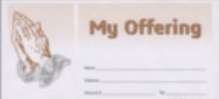

On June 20, 2022, we recognize Juneteenth, a holiday that reflects the ideals of Respect Life. President Joe Biden signed the **Juneteenth** National Independence Day Act into law on June 17, 2021. As its name implies, Juneteenth (a combination of "June"

and "nineteenth") is celebrated and observed on June 19 each year commemorating the emancipation of the enslaved African Americans back in 1865. But since it falls on a Sunday this year, the federal holiday will be observed on Monday, June 20.

Juneteenth, which commemorates the end of slavery in the United States, was officially recognized as a federal holiday in 2021. However, it's been a pillar in American history since 1865. Although slaves had formally been freed by the Emancipation Proclamation in 1863, it didn't apply to those working in states under Confederate control. On June 19, 1865, two months after the Civil War ended, Major General Gordon Granger rode into Galveston, Texas with a decree to free enslaved people. The streets erupted with song, dance and cheer — and Juneteenth was born. Today, this holiday is significant to encourage freedom and equality among all people.

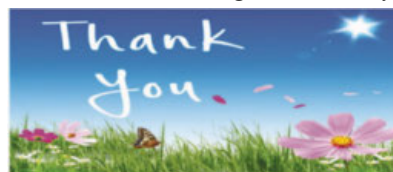

MIGRANT MINISTRY: Our SOS Migrant Ministry has been helping our migrant brothers and sisters on the Eastern Shore for over 15 years! We share our SOS hospitality and care to the migrant workers who toil in the fields and work on the multiple farming camps to harvest and gather produce and crops. On most of their working days, these workers are up at dawn and work until sunset out on the land in the summer heat. We hope to "outreach" to the migrant workers by sharing resources and supplies that can help them with their daily living and in their work, since they do not have too many opportunities or options to travel or shop at the few stores that are on the Eastern Shore.

Even though the Covid-19 pandemic impacted our direct efforts to visit the migrant workers to only a few scheduled trips over the past two years, we continued to be respectful and adhered to camp concerns of social distancing as we dropped off supplies and forwarded care packages on behalf of SOS. We are currently reviewing our plans to continue our mission to serve our migrant brothers and sisters.

If you are interested in learning more about our Migrant Ministry or if you are able to speak or understand Spanish and/or French, we would like you to consider joining our ministry for the summer or be available as a possible "Santa" to help bring over presents in December for the Christmas Holiday! We will likely be making a few trips over the summer months to relay supplies to migrant camps or to the Eastern Shore parishes once we have been given permission to visit the camps.
