15th Sunday in Ordinary Time—July 10, 2022

The parable of the "good Samaritan" in our Gospel today teaches that everyone in need is our neighbor, not just the people who are near or dear to us. The message of Jesus in the Gospel is clear: there are no limits as to whom the law of love must be applied. A neighbor is not simply one who lives next door or in our town or country. A neighbor is not of geography but of the heart. The new thing in Jesus' teaching of neighborly love is his insistence that all humanity is one big neighborhood.

To bring home his point that everyone in need is our neighbor not just the people we live with, not just the people who are near and dear to us, Jesus once again tells us the story of the Good Samaritan. This man regarded as an enemy by the Jewish establishment is the one who finally proves himself to be neighbor to the man in need. A neighbor then is anyone and everyone without exception.

Today, we are reminded how Jesus broke down the walls of division and the borders of prejudice and suspicion that humans erected between "us" and "them." Today is the day to identify and tear down all the borders we have erected, such as suspicion, prejudice, biases and the like, between those who belong to us (and are therefore deserving of our love and concern) and those who don't (those who could possibly go to hell). Sometimes these walls of division are religious in nature or typical stereo-typing, sometimes they are ethnic and racial in nature, sometimes they are social and economic. Today, Jesus challenges us all to dismantle these walls. This way we work with Jesus to realize his dream of the world as a neighborhood without borders.

Let us the pray for the grace to have the kind of heart that will make us good Samaritans in whatever situation we find ourselves. Let us keep on loving as Jesus has loved us. Amen.

Spending time in prayer may seem, on the outside, to be a passive thing; however, it is anything but! Our world is in desperate need of hope, of renewal, of a "turning back" to the things of God. By visiting Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, we take up the best weapon for the battles of our age and contribute to the healing of our culture.

Cultivating a Eucharistic life of adoration also bears tremendous fruit in our own hearts and lives. We cannot spend time in the rays of His Eucharistic Presence without receiving His grace, His love, His mercy, His peace. As we gaze upon Him Face-to-Face, we are transformed little by little into a closer reflection of His divine image."
