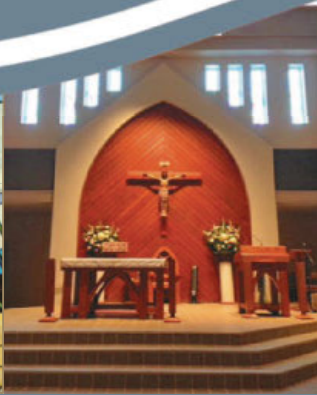

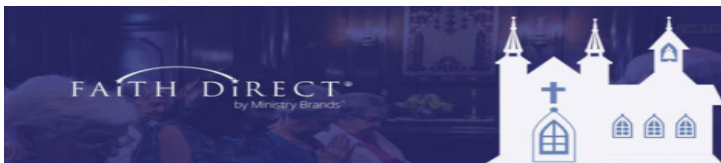

16th Sunday in Ordinary Time—July 17, 2022

Today's Gospel talks about the two famous sisters, Martha and Mary. There's no question that they both loved Jesus and they both wanted to serve Him. However, they did serve Him in two different ways Mary, who is more interested in knowing the Lord of the work; and Martha, who is busy with work of the Lord. For Martha, service comes first, for Mary relationship comes first. However, the point of the story is not to invite us to choose between being a Martha or a Mary, but to choose between work and prayer in our life, to have a balanced life, to balance prayer and work/service. There are people who see Martha in this story as the material girl and Mary as the spiritual one. But this way of thinking in terms of separation between spirit and matter does not belong to the gospel of Luke. Rather, Luke presents Martha and Mary as two sisters who are both interested in the Lord, two women who both want to please the Lord. The difference between them is the manner in which they go about trying to please the Lord. Martha takes the way of service or working for the Lord. Mary takes the way of relationship or being with the Lord. But again, the point of the story is not to invite us to choose between being a Martha or a Mary. The true disciple/follower of Christ needs to be both Martha and Mary.

Today, we salute all the "Marthas" in our midst who go out of their way to do all sorts of errands for the Lord. We salute all the "Marys" who drop everything to be with the Lord. Whoever you are, whether you are a "Martha" or a "Mary," just make sure that everything begins, continues and ends with the Lord, for the Lord and through the Lord.

Today's Gospel invites us, all of us Christians, not to choose between Mary and Martha but to be both a "Mary," who sits with devotion at the Lord's feet listening to His word, a "Martha," who throws herself with energy into the business of serving the Lord in our parish and in the wider community.

Let us keep on loving and serving the Lord as Mary and Martha did. Amen.

"The most powerful thing we can do on this earth with our time is to spend it in Eucharistic Adoration. Nothing can do more to change the world, to bring peace, to convert hearts, to make reparation for the many evils committed. Spending time in prayer may seem, on the outside, to be a passive thing; however, it is anything but! Our world is in desperate need of hope, of renewal, of a "turning back" to the things of God. By visiting Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, we take up the best weapon for the battles of our age and contribute to the healing of our culture.

Cultivating a Eucharistic life of adoration also bears tremendous fruit in our own hearts and lives. We cannot spend time in the rays of His Eucharistic Presence without receiving His grace, His love, His mercy, His peace. As we gaze upon Him Face-to-Face, we are transformed little by little into a closer reflection of His divine image."

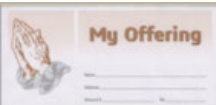

On June 30, 2022, Pope Francis noted in his homily at the Mass for the “Church to promote a culture of care.” He reflected on the meaning of two phrases, “getting up” and “fight the good fight” from the liturgy readings on the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. He referred to “today’s Christian community” to be “engaged in the synodal process.” The Pope noted that, “we experience forms of resistance that prevent us from setting out, including laziness or fear of change, leading to spiritual mediocrity. We are called by the Synod now in progress, “to become a Church that gets up, one that is not turned in on itself, but capable of pressing forward, leaving behind its own prisons and setting out to meet the world.” He encouraged that we are all called to be missionary disciples, with everyone offering their own contribution.”

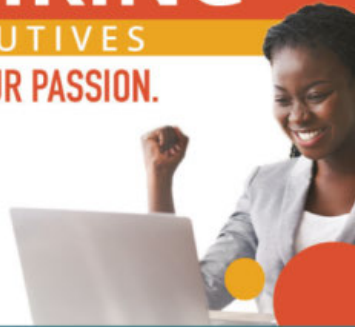
