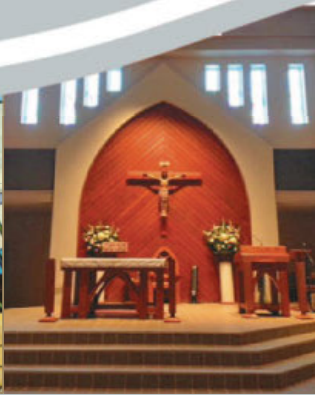
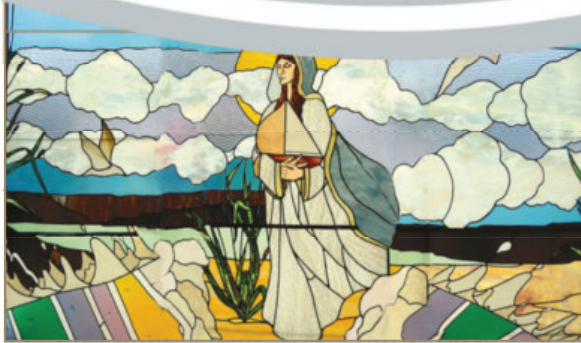

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time—July 24, 2022

In today's Gospel, we heard about the generosity of God to our requests. God our Father is a generous, loving and giving Father who goes out of his way for us. Today we are reminded that genuine prayer begins with the risk of asking ("Lord, teach us to pray.") Prayer is entrusting oneself to silence and uncertainty. Because in prayer, God is not at our disposal. We give Him the freedom to answer "yes" or "no" or "wait." Let us always keep in mind then, that when we pray to God, we are not in control and, therefore, we should leave ourselves open to possibilities. But God definitely answers all our prayers. 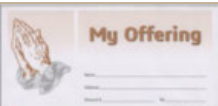

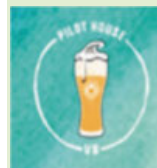
