

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time-August 14, 2022

Jesus, in today's Gospel, reminded his disciples that he did not come to establish peace on earth but division. It means that the peace that Jesus offers us is not the cozy, comfortable kind of peace, but a peace that is borne out of sacrifice, pain and anguish. As someone once said, the gospel comforts the disturbed and disturbs the comfortable.

Our basic catechism describes the Church in heaven as the Church triumphant, the Church in purgatory as the Church suffering, and the Church on earth as the Church militant. So, let us remember that while we live, we continue to struggle, to grow and move on. Let us then continue to ask, to seek the truth, to confront evil and lies with good and the truth in our life journey.

The presence of Christ in our lives gives us peace, but He will disturb our peace to challenge us to grow and become better persons. God's love is both tender and tough. The main focus of our journey to God's heart is God Himself, and not the sunshine or the storm we encounter along the way. In other words, the presence of God is what should give us peace. whether we go through peaceful or raging waters on our journey.

Let us keep on believing in God's love and faithfulness. Let us keep on loving as Jesus did. Amen.
