


Jeremiah 31:31-34







- Please exit the church beginning with the back pews, followed by the middle and finally the front pews. DO NOT congregate in the vestibule or nave of the church



**Swieconka* (sh-vee-en-soon-kah) is one of the most enduring and beloved Polish traditions.

Baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday. The basket is traditionally lined with a white linen or lace napkin and decorated with sprigs of boxwood (*bukszpan*), the typical Easter evergreen. This food is shared on Easter morning in a ritual breaking of the fast.

Observing the beautiful foods and creations of other parishioners is one of the special joys of the event.


