## GOSPEL

Matthew 2: 1-12

We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage." When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, He inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet: *And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel.*" Then Herod called the magi secretly and ascertained from them the time of the star's appearance. He sent them to Bethlehem and said,

"Go and search diligently for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage." After their audience with the king they set out. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

### NICENE CREED


## Epiphany of the Lord

The Irish playwright and poet Oscar Wilde, (fellow Dubliner), wrote: *"To live is the rarest thing in the world. Most people exist, that is all."*

Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord which refers to the manifestation of Jesus to the world represented by the three kings. Epiphany means *"manifestation"* or *"showing forth."* The Gospels paint a truly beautiful and sentimental picture of the birth of the Lord: a miraculous star, Angel choirs, shepherds watching over the sheep, the Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, sheep, cattle, three wise men (Kings), a humble stable, and a lowly donkey. It's the stuff of poetry. And at the center of it all is a small child, a baby, in fact, and that is Jesus. With all the beautiful details, we can be in danger of losing sight of what is being revealed, of what is most important. First, God the Creator of all things, who cannot be held or encompassed by anything He has created, makes Himself a creature, a man. God, who is pure spirit, or pure being, takes on a created form in flesh – that's what Incarnation means: fleshed. Second, God does this because of our need for salvation and, most importantly, and even more astonishingly, because He loves us. This is what is being revealed, manifested, shown forth – God, the uncreated became a creature, and came into the world to save me **because He loves me.**

How should we respond to this love of God? As Wilde observed, many people simply manage to "get through life." Many rarely say what they want to say, do what they want to do, live the life they want to live, or be the people they feel in their hearts they were created to be. Don't get me wrong, I'm not advocating that people simply live as they like in

some sort of simple hedonism. To "live" as Wilde suggests, is to realize the full potential of who we are and to overcome the fears that prevent us from being who we are created to be and live the life we are created to live.



The truth is that God created us; and God created us for a purpose. The very reason for being is to be loved by God and to love God. This is our purpose and meaning for being/existing. It is not a simple response to God's love or two sides of a coin. No! We are created, in our very nature, our very DNA, our very being, and our reason for being, is to be loved by God and to love God. When we do this, we will truly know what life is meant to be about, what life truly is, who we truly are. When we live like this, we will manifest or show forth our true self. That is an Epiphany. That is what God does at the Feast of the Epiphany – He shows forth His true self – a God who is willing to become a creature (child) in order to save the children He loves.

The proper response to this love of God is to dare to be who God created us to be and live as He created us to live. When we dare to be who God wants us to be, we are making present in the world a gift from God, we are fulfilling our purpose, we are manifesting something God wants to reveal. That is an Epiphany. *"To live is the rarest thing in the world. Most people exist, that is all."* Life is too short to simply just exist – dare to live – dare to be who God created you to be.

## Child Protection & Virtus

As we gear up to return to activities around the parish, we want to make sure that all of our parishioners know about the Archdiocese's Decree on Child Protection.

- **The definition of a Volunteer is:** an adult who is not a cleric or an employee (for example, a catechist, scout leader, coach, cafeteria volunteer, etc.) who functions in any capacity to assist in activities with children. This includes all adults accompanying children on any overnight activity.
- **The definition of a Child includes:** a person under eighteen years of age; for purposes of this Decree, "Child" also includes "Vulnerable Adults" as defined below.
- **The definition of a Vulnerable Adult:** any person 18 years of age or older whose ability to physically protect him/herself from any form of abuse (as defined by the Decree) is impaired due to a persistent mental, physical, cognitive, or developmental delay.

This means all adults who volunteer in any capacity need to do Virtus training and an online background check prior to volunteering.
