Fr. Ben's Column

Without light there is only darkness


About 40 years ago, I was taking a walk with a friend on a country estate in Ireland. There was a pheasant shoot going on at that time and we could hear the shots in the distance. As we walked, one shot sounded pretty close and I said to my friend that soon we might need to duck to avoid being shot. This chap was a scientist and liked to show people how much he knew, so he replied that by the time we heard the shot, it would have already hit us. He went on to tell me that this was because the bullet travels faster than the speed of sound. Actually, I looked it up and sound travels at 343 meters per second.

The speed of light is even faster than the speed of sound. Light travels at 299,792,458 meters per second, and according to modern physics, light is the fastest thing in the universe. Natural light, as we know it and see it today, comes from stars. All the natural light in the universe comes from stars and the closest star to us is the sun. Without stars, there is only darkness. Interestingly, scientists today say that light existed before stars, before the atom, before anything came into existence, even before "the big bang." Does that sound incredible!

The Book of Genesis tells us that on the first day of creation, God separated the light from the darkness. Genesis also tells us that on the fourth day, God created the sun and the stars. God gave light before He created the celestial bodies we count on for light. Now, does that describe an awesome God or what! A God who can create light without the sun and the stars – now that's a powerful God.

This week, we will celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. It is the tradition of the Church that on this day, all of the candles

used in church for the upcoming year are blessed. That's because the Gospel reading for Mass proclaims that Joseph and Mary brought the child Jesus to the Temple and the prophet Simeon recognized the Child as the "Light" of God for the world. The image of light is so important that it has become the primary image of Christ, and so at Easter, we have a pascal fire that is kept burning in the pascal candle. We receive that flame at Baptism when we receive the "Light of Christ," which, of course, symbolizes that we are to be the light of Christ in the world.



Just think how incredible light is: it travels at 299,792,458 meters per second, it existed before anything was made, and without it, there is no possibility of life existing anywhere. Yet, this natural light is insignificant compared to the Light of God that enters the Temple as a little child. This child will light the world and bring life to every soul. This child brings the light of meaning to all humans, and in fact, to all existence for all time. Now that is a Light worth having. Even the unclean spirits in today's Gospel are smart enough to see and recognize this Light.

It is this light, the light of Christ, that is given to us to be kept burning brightly. We are sent by God to be a light in the darkness. We are to be a light in our time, in our homes, marriages, families, community, and nation. Now this light brings real life, and without this light, there is only darkness. Without stars, there is no light, only darkness, so be a star and burn bright.
