### Power goes out from Jesus

Many years ago, I went with my mother with a pilgrimage group from Ireland to the shrine of Our Lady at Lourdes, France. A few days after arriving at Lourdes there was a side excursion by bus and I noticed that the people on the bus were young women but there were also some "older women," but no men. That evening I asked some of the women in our group where the bus was going earlier that day. They told me that the bus was full of young women who were having difficulties conceiving and the older women were mothers who were in Lourdes looking for miracles for their daughters who also could not conceive. So, like a fool, I asked, where was the bus taking them. Well, it turns out that not far from Lourdes there is an old bridge built by the Romans and since those days a superstition has grown up that if women have had difficulty conceiving and they walk backwards over this bridge, toward Spain, they will then be successful in conceiving. The bus was full of devout Catholic women in Lourdes looking for a miracle and yet here they were hedging their bets with an old pagan superstition. The desire to have children is indeed powerful. And superstitions can be powerful also as they promise something we dearly hope for or promise deliverance from something we dread.



There are all sorts of powers in the world and in our lives: the police have the power to arrest; judges have the power to imprison or liberate; Roman Emperors had the power of life and death; Adolf Hitler had the power to mesmerize huge audiences and seduce a nation to doing terrible evil; while John F. Kennedy had the power to inspire; priests have the power to change bread and wine into the Body and Blood of the Lord and to forgive sins.

The Gospel today gives us a contrast of divine power. Although it does not mention the Ark of the Covenant it seems to be present anyway. You will remember that the Ark contained the tablets on which Moses had written the Ten Commandments. It also contained some of the Mana that God gave to the Israelites as food in the desert, but it was especially created as a dwelling place for the Spirit of God. It was so holy that only the High Priest could touch the Ark. When it was carried, four priests carried it using long poles, so they did not touch it. In battle, power went out from the Ark and struck down Israel's enemies. Poor Uzzah was instantly killed when he touched the Ark even though he was saving it from falling to the ground. From the Ark went out the power of God.

Now, in the Gospel we also see power going out from Jesus. The woman who has suffered all her adult life with illness reached out and touched Jesus. Unlike Uzzah who was struck down by the power of God, this poor woman is healed when she touched Jesus because "power" has gone out from Him. Later, Jesus reaches out and takes the little girl's hand, and power goes out from Him, and she rises from the dead. Jesus is the new Ark of the Covenant that contains the power and Spirit of God, and this power now brings healing, life, hope, and grace. From Jesus comes healing and life.

It seems to me that we have the power within us to do evil or do good, to bring illness or healing, to bring darkness or light, to bring death or life. In fact, through Baptism and Holy Communion, the Spirit of God, which dwelled in the Ark and in the Lord, this same Spirit dwells in us – true power. What do we do with the power we have? What do people experience when they reach out to us or when we encounter them? Does darkness or light, evil or good, death or life flow from us?


