

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate the beautiful Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, it gives me a chance to address a wonderful group of folks in our parish: godparents! (Yesterday I participated in the baptism of my new godson, Isaac, so this theme certainly applies to me!) At baptism and confirmation, especially, godparents assume an important role in providing guidance and inspiration in living the faith. However, this doesn't always happen. Recently I read an article about a number of dioceses in Italy that are suspending the role of godparents. The public expectation about the role of godparents had become so confused that several regions chose to eliminate, for a while, any possibility for anybody to serve as a godparent. Hopefully we won't get to this point. As a witness to the sacraments, the godparent is not an honorary title given to a nice relative who nevertheless doesn't practice her faith, or a non-Christian neighbor with enough means to raise the child properly if the parents become incapacitated. The Church recognizes that godparents are to inspire a vibrant life of faith, and their own active participation in the sacramental life of the Church is just one part of this. For those of us who are godparents, we seek the grace to deepen our faith and express it more fervently. For those who are not, I invite you to speak with me about getting former marriages annulled, about receiving the sacrament of confirmation, or about witnessing to the truth and beauty of our faith. Perhaps, soon, a family will ask you to be a godparent. What a blessing to be able to (honestly) accept that invitation! God bless you! Fr Grather

Hermanos y hermanas in Cristo,

Mientras celebramos la hermosa Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor, me da la oportunidad de dirigirme a un maravilloso grupo de personas en nuestra parroquia: ¡los padrinos y las madrinas! (Ayer participé en el bautismo de mi nuevo ahijado, Isaac, ¡así que este tema ciertamente se aplica a mí!) En el bautismo y la confirmación, especialmente, los padrinos y las madrinas asumen un papel importante al brindar orientación e inspiración para vivir la fe. Sin embargo, esto no siempre sucede. Recientemente lei un artículo sobre varias diócesis en Italia que están suspendiendo el papel de padrinos. La expectativa pública sobre el papel de los padrinos se había vuelto tan confusa que varias regiones optaron por eliminar, por un tiempo, cualquier posibilidad de que alguien sirviera como padrino. Ojalá no lleguemos a este punto. Como testigo de los sacramentos, el padrino no es un título honorífico otorgado a un pariente agradable que, sin embargo, no practica su fe, o un vecino no cristiano con los medios suficientes para criar adecuadamente al niño si los padres quedan incapacitados. La Iglesia reconoce que los padrinos deben inspirar una vida de fe vibrante, y su propia participación activa en la vida sacramental de la Iglesia es solo una parte de esto. Para quienes somos padrinos, buscamos la gracia para profundizar nuestra fe y expresarla con más fervor. Para aquellos que no lo son, los invito a hablar conmigo sobre la anulación de matrimonios anteriores, sobre recibir el sacramento de la confirmación o sobre dar testimonio de la verdad y la belleza de nuestra fe. Quizás, pronto, una familia te pida que seas padrino. ¡Qué bendición poder aceptar Fr Smalle (honestamente) esa invitación! ¡Dios te bendiga!
