

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Next weekend we kick off our annual observance of Catholic Schools Week! I'm blessed to have a leadership role here at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic School, where I regularly witness the awesome things happening in corridors, classrooms and conversations. Our students aren't just learning academic subjects, but they're being infused with Gospel values to build healthy relationships with others, with the world, and, most importantly, with God. Every educator has a list of humorous stories. Here's one I've brought with me from Sacred Heart Catholic School in Danville. Reflecting on the legacy of St. Joan of Arc, a little girl wondered aloud how she and Noah managed to fit so many animals into such a small boat! I was happy to report that Noah's ark was spelled differently and meant something very different. This story demonstrates a couple beautiful things about Catholic education. First, our kids learn to THINK. They learn to think critically, to make connections, and to use their imagination. Second, our kids THINK ABOUT FAITH. I suspect many kids in our community have never heard either of Noah or St. Joan of Arc. In Catholic schools, however, our kids reflect on the legacy of holy men and women, and look for ways to continue that legacy in their words and actions. Our Lady of Lourdes students will serve in several roles at each Mass on January 29 and 30. Please pray for them. God bless you!

¡El próximo fin de semana comenzamos nuestra celebración anual de la Semana de las Escuelas Católicas! Tengo la suerte de tener un papel de liderazgo aquí en la Escuela Católica Nuestra Señora de Lourdes, donde regularmente soy testigo de las cosas maravillosas que suceden en los pasillos, las aulas y las conversaciones. Nuestros estudiantes no solo están aprendiendo materias académicas, sino que están siendo infundidos con los valores del Evangelio para construir relaciones saludables con los demás, con el mundo y, lo más importante, con Dios. Cada educador tiene una lista de historias humorísticas. Aquí hay uno que traje conmigo de la Escuela Católica del Sagrado Corazón en Danville. Reflexionando sobre el legado de Santa Juana de Arco, una niña pequeña se preguntó en voz alta cómo ella y Noah lograron meter tantos animales en un bote tan pequeño. Me alegró informar que el arca de Noé se deletreaba de manera diferente y significaba algo muy diferente. Esta historia demuestra dos cosas hermosas sobre la educación católica. Primero, nuestros niños aprenden a PENSAR. Aprenden a pensar críticamente, a hacer conexiones ya usar su imaginación. Segundo, nuestros hijos PIENSAN EN LA FE. Sospecho que muchos niños de nuestra comunidad nunca han oído hablar de Noé ni de Santa Juana de Arco. En las escuelas católicas, sin embargo, nuestros niños reflexionan sobre el legado de hombres y mujeres santos y buscan formas de continuar ese legado en sus palabras y acciones. 
SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE!
