



# Celebrating the event of Jesus' Resurrection!

# Today's the day that changed humanity, and history, and the world!

Today is the Day of the Lord Jesus' Resurrection from the dead following His death on the cross!

Together, we sing: "This is the day that the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad!"

# Together, we exclaim: "Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!"

This year and every year, our Paschal celebration of the Easter Season is our sacred and joyful time for celebrating Jesus' new life following His suffering and death three days earlier on the cross.

**For all of us who ae Catholic Christians**, the Lord Jesus' Resurrection is essential to all that we believe, to our Christian way of life, and to our ultimate hope that Jesus will share with us His own resurrection to new and eternal life!

**Because of Jesus' Resurrection**, the Church and Christianity were born of God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Because of Jesus' Resurrection, the Lord's Good News came to be shared with the world. Because of Jesus' Resurrection, a new way of life and love and mercy has changed humanity throughout the past twenty centuries and today as well.

**For others**, Easter Sunday is simply one day to celebrate the springtime.

To begin the great Easter Vigil each year, we first welcome the new light of the Lord's Resurrection by blessing the Easter Fire and then lighting the Easter Candle (the 'Paschal Candle'). Once the Paschal Candle is processed into the sanctuary, the Exsultet (the Easter Song of Praise) is then sung either by the clergy or cantors, choir, and assembly. Today, many parishes employ a more modern version of the Exsultet so that everyone can easily participate. However, so that you might read and know this beautiful, traditional Easter Proclamation, we present the complete Exsultet:

Exult, let them exult, the hosts of heaven, exult, let Angel ministers of God exult, let the trumpet of salvation sound aloud our mighty King's triumph! Be glad, let earth be glad, as glory floods her, ablaze with light from her eternal King, let all corners of the earth be glad, knowing an end to gloom and darkness.

Rejoice, let Mother Church also rejoice, arrayed with the lightning of His glory, let this holy building shake with joy, filled with the mighty voices of the peoples.

Therefore, dearest friends, standing in the awesome glory of this holy light, invoke with me, I ask you, the mercy of God almighty, that He, who has been pleased to number me, though unworthy, among the Levites, may pour into me His light unshadowed, that I may sing this candle's perfect praises.

It is truly right and just, with ardent love of mind and heart and with devoted service of our voice, to acclaim our God invisible, the almighty Father, and Jesus Christ, our Lord, His Son, His Only Begotten, Who for our sake paid Adam's debt to the eternal Father, and, pouring out His own dear Blood, wiped clean the record of our ancient sinfulness.

These, then, are the feasts of Passover, in which is slain the Lamb, the one true Lamb, whose Blood anoints the doorposts of believers.

# + + +

This is the night, when once you led our forebears, Israel's children,

from slavery in Egypt and made them pass dry-shod through the Red Sea.

# + + +

This is the night that with a pillar of fire banished the darkness of sin.

This is the night that even now, throughout the world, sets Christian believers apart from worldly vices and from the gloom of sin, leading them to grace and joining them to His holy ones.

This is the night when Christ broke the prison-bars of death, and rose victorious from the underworld.

O wonder of your humble care for us!

O love, O charity beyond all telling, to ransom a slave you gave away your Son! O truly necessary sin of Adam, destroyed completely by the Death of Christ! O happy fault that earned so great, so glorious a Redeemer!

This is the night of which it is written: the night shall be as bright as day, dazzling is the night for me, and full of gladness.

The sanctifying power of this night dispels wickedness, washes faults away, restores innocence to the fallen, and joy to mourners, drives out hatred, fosters concord, and brings down the mighty.

On this, your night of grace, O holy Father, accept this candle, a solemn offering, the work of bees and of your servants' hands, an evening sacrifice of praise, this gift from your most holy Church.

Therefore, O Lord, we pray you that this candle, hallowed to the honor of Your name, may persevere undimmed, to overcome the darkness of this night. Receive it as a pleasing fragrance, and let it mingle with the lights of heaven. May this flame be found still burning by the Morning Star; the one Morning Star who never sets, Christ Your Son, who, coming back from death's domain, has shed His peaceful light on humanity -- and lives forever and ever. Amen!

Now that Dorothy is concluding her 23 years of service to Saint Philip Parish, we wish her God's blessings and goodness now and in the years ahead!



While our volunteers and donors make much smaller sacrifices by donating to and volunteering for our friends in need, they are nonetheless rewarded many times over for their sacrifice. Their reward comes from the satisfaction of knowing that they are doing God's work by serving His children, and by the wonderful connections that they make with our friends in need. Our friends in need may feel beaten down and defeated when they come to us for help, but we try to give them hope, dignity, and love through the assistance they receive. As you celebrate Jesus' resurrection, please pray that our friends in need are given the strength to go on even when times seem most bleak, as they did for the disciples after Jesus' death but before His resurrection; and pray also that our volunteers and donors are renewed in their determination to serve our friends in need with a sincere love of God and neighbor.

We would like to extend a very sincere thanks to everyone who donated to our Lenten food drive. While it is hard for us to quantify the amount of food donated, we believe that this is the most food that we have received for any of our food drives! This food will allow us to continue to serve the approximately 70 households to which we deliver food each month and the people that we deliver emergency food to on an as-needed basis. Your donations will also help us as we increase the amount of food that we give our "food families" in order to provide them with additional assistance. Thank you so much.

This week, your generous donations enabled us to provide a man with \$234 to have his driver's license restored; a woman was assisted with \$60 toward her electric bill; a single mother was given two beds for her children; a woman was assisted with \$150 toward her gas bill; and a woman was given \$300 toward her electric bill.
