



To begin the great Easter Vigil each year, we first welcome the new light of the Lord's Resurrection by blessing the Easter Fire and then lighting the Easter Candle (the 'Paschal Candle'). Once the Paschal Candle is processed into the sanctuary, the Exsultet (the Easter Song of Praise) is then sung either by the clergy or cantors, choir, and assembly. Today, many parishes employ a more modern version of the Exsultet so that everyone can easily participate. However, so that you might read and know this beautiful, traditional Easter Proclamation, we present the complete Exsultet:

Exult, let them exult, the hosts of heaven, exult, let Angel ministers of God exult, let the trumpet of salvation sound aloud our mighty King's triumph! Be glad, let earth be glad, as glory floods her, ablaze with light from her eternal King, let all corners of the earth be glad, knowing an end to gloom and darkness.

Rejoice, let Mother Church also rejoice, arrayed with the lightning of His glory, let this holy building shake with joy, filled with the mighty voices of the peoples.

+ + +

Therefore, dearest friends, standing in the awesome glory of this holy light, invoke with me, I ask you, the mercy of God almighty, that He, who has been pleased to number me, though unworthy, among the Levites, may pour into me His light unshadowed, that I may sing this candle's perfect praises.

It is truly right and just, with ardent love of mind and heart and with devoted service of our voice, to acclaim our God invisible, the almighty Father, and Jesus Christ, our Lord, His Son, His Only Begotten, Who for our sake paid Adam's debt to the eternal Father, and, pouring out His own dear Blood, wiped clean the record of our ancient sinfulness.

+ + +

These, then, are the feasts of Passover, in which is slain the Lamb, the one true Lamb, whose Blood anoints the doorposts of believers.

+ + +

This is the night, when once You led our forebears, Israel's children,

from slavery in Egypt and made them pass dry-shod through the Red Sea.

+ + +

This is the night that with a pillar of fire banished the darkness of sin.

This is the night that even now, throughout the world, sets Christian believers apart from worldly vices and from the gloom of sin, leading them to grace and joining them to His holy ones.

This is the night when Christ broke the prison-bars of death, and rose victorious from the underworld.

O wonder of Your humble care for us!

O love, O charity beyond all telling, to ransom a slave You gave away Your Son! O truly necessary sin of Adam, destroyed completely by the Death of Christ! O happy fault that earned so great, so glorious a Redeemer!

This is the night of which it is written: the night shall be as bright as day, dazzling is the night for me, and full of gladness.

The sanctifying power of this night dispels wickedness, washes faults away, restores innocence to the fallen, and joy to mourners, drives out hatred, fosters concord, and brings down the mighty.

+ + +

On this, Your night of grace, O holy Father, accept this candle, a solemn offering, the work of bees and of Your servants' hands, an evening sacrifice of praise, this gift from Your most holy Church.

Therefore, O Lord, we pray You that this candle, hallowed to the honor of Your name, may persevere undimmed, to overcome the darkness of this night. Receive it as a pleasing fragrance, and let it mingle with the lights of heaven. May this flame be found still burning by the Morning Star; the one Morning Star who never sets, Christ Your Son, who, coming back from death's domain, has shed His peaceful light on humanity -- and lives forever and ever. Amen!

As we begin the 50 days of the joyous Easter Season, NEW Daily Reflection booklets are available NOW at both of our churches for the Easter Season.

Easter is the season for us to celebrate joyfully the wonderful event of the Lord Jesus' Resurrection from the grave. Having become more faithful and holy disciples during Lent, the Season of the Resurrection is our seven weeks to renew our belief in the Resurrection. It is the season when we rejoice in this primary event and belief of Catholic Christianity.

Hopefully, our Easter Season Reflection booklets will benefit our parish community throughout these weeks.

— A Memorial Opportunity — NEW shrine candles in Saint Philip church

This month, in Saint Philip church, our parish will replace the shrine candles located on the side altars dedicated to the Blessed Mother and to Saint Joseph. Most of the shrine candles on those altars were broken in recent decades, and so, as we continue to refurbish the small items of Saint Philip church, those shrine candles will finally be replaced.

This purchase of 36 shrine candles presents a new Jubilee Year opportunity for our parish members to contribute a memorial donation for these NEW shrine candles – and to add an inscription to one or more candles. We are purchasing 24 BLUE shrine candles for the Blessed Mother's altar – and 12 FROSTED shrine candles for the Saint Joseph altar.

Since each candle base and glass container costs \$200, a memorial donation of \$200 will fund one candle (*the base and the glass candle container*) on which we will place a printed label (*for example, "In memory of...", "From the _____ family...", "In thanksgiving for / from...", etc.*).



REFLECTIONS FROM MARYANN: In the Gospel for Easter Sunday we hear, "*Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark and saw the stone removed from the tomb.*" In that same Gospel, we hear that when the other disciple with Peter after hearing of the empty tomb, arrived at the tomb, he saw the burial cloths but did not go into the tomb. Easter is a



Feast of tombstones rolled away. Pope Francis reminds us that as we experience tombstones of discouragement, worry, fear, and concern, Jesus asks us to remember that He can remove the stones and lead us to new life in Christ. How much are we like the disciple who saw the burial cloths but was hesitant at first to enter the empty tomb. How hesitant are we to believe that Jesus wants us to let go of that which keeps us from the life of Christ and to trust that Jesus will give us New Life. What are the "stones" in our life that keep us buried in the past. What are the "stones" in our life that keep us from going forward to live the life that Christ wants for each of us. Let us ask Jesus to remove the "stone" and allow us to believe in the hope, love and goodness that awaits each of us this Easter Season.
