

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Saint Rose,

This weekend, the Fifteenth in Ordinary Time, we read and hear the gospel account of the sending of the twelve apostles to the bi-ways and highways spreading the Good News. I am always intrigued when this narrative emerges in the three-year liturgical cycle, especially by the fact that Jesus instructed the apostles not to take anything with them “no food, no sack, no money in their belts”. A practical reason why Jesus advises them not to take these items for the journey could have been to avoid confrontation with robbers who ambushed travelers along the roads. I believe it was more a matter of keeping a focus due to the many distractions that hinder a person’s ability to complete a task or responsibility. More intriguing with this narrative, in contrast to what Jesus charges them not to take for the journey, is the fact that he encourages them to wear sandals on their feet.

It is as if our Lord is preparing his intimate followers with the most important aspect of their work in life – being on the move. Being rooted and grounded in the faith is what allows us to be moved wherever the Lord desires. Faith, and most importantly, discipleship, is not a matter of sitting idle and letting the world pass by. Our baptismal faith charges us to actively witness to Christ and his teachings in the world. We do that in many ways. As pandemic restrictions end and some normalcy enters our daily regimen of life again, our ability to actively witness to the faith in the world will become possible again.

Give thought and prayerfully consider your own involvement in the many ministries our parish offers. It might be one of the many outreach ministries we offer to support the lives of people in need, or any of the liturgical related services that help to enrich our public prayer. One of the clear realities I have noticed these early days as pastor of our parish are the many talented and devoted members who share their time and talent for the sake of God’s kingdom. I find that to be a most noble gesture of responding to Christ’s charge to go out to the highways and bi-ways. When we invest our time and abilities to a cause, great things can happen. It becomes a blessing to us personally and a blessing on the cause or effort. Simply, the encounter becomes a win-win situation.

Hoping that the summer days we experience find you taking time to appreciate the beauty of creation and embracing all of the graces offered to us from God.

**Monthly Rosary Prayed for the Sick**

Anyone can join us this Thursday, July 15 at 6:45 pm in the church.

Monsignor Charles Singler is a native of Sandusky, Ohio. Born on June 16, 1958 to the late Charles and Rita Singler, he is the oldest of five children. He is the proud uncle of ten nieces and nephews and nine great nieces and nephews.

He attended St. Mary's Elementary School and is a 1976 alumnus of St. Mary's Central Catholic High School in Sandusky. Upon graduation from high school, Monsignor enrolled at St. Gregory Seminary College in Cincinnati, where he completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in English in 1980. He continued his seminary formation at Mt. St. Mary's Seminary of the West in Cincinnati where he earned a Master of Divinity degree in 1984. He was ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Toledo on June 9, 1984 by the late Bishop James R. Hoffman. Since ordination, he completed a Master of Arts degree at the University of Notre Dame, Notre Dame, IN (1994) and a Doctor of Ministry degree from the University of St. Thomas, St. Paul, MN (2006).

Monsignor's pastoral experiences have been wide and varied the past 37 years. In addition to active memberships on a number of diocesan committees and commissions past and present, he has served as a parochial vicar, pastor, rector of our diocesan cathedral, seminary formator, director of the diocesan office of worship, director of diocesan priestly vocations. Prior to his recent appointment as pastor of Saint Rose Parish, he served as pastor of St. Nicholas Parish, Miller City and Holy Family Parish, New Cleveland.

Monsignor Chas is no stranger to the Saint Rose community, having served here as parochial vicar (1996 - 1999) under the pastorate of Fr. John Thomas.

He went above and beyond to make sure we understood what we were doing.” Her parents, Randy and Tracy, agree that “Saint Rose really prepared her for her advanced high school classes.” Rachel also fondly remembers the class trips she and her classmates took in middle school while at Saint Rose. “They were really fun,” she remarked. Along with her parents and brother, Rachel also participates in Eucharistic ministry for the residents at Perrysburg Commons and Heartland, a ministry which Rachel says she will be happy to return to once Covid restrictions are lifted.

Her service to her church and her community is unwavering, and her strong faith shows in everything she does. Even through disappointments and challenges, she has pushed ahead and works incredibly hard to reach her goals. 


