### *From the Pastor's Desk*

Dear Parishioners,

The official installation of your new pastor next Sunday, July 25 at the 12 Noon Lord's Day Mass, is fast approaching. We will have the pleasure and honor of welcoming Bishop Daniel Thomas to lead us in the Lord's Day Mass and celebrate the Order for the Installation of a Pastor. Additionally, Monsignor Walter "Tad" Oxley, newly appointed diocesan Vicar for Clergy, will be joining us as well to read the decree of appointment during the installation rite. It will be a great privilege and honor have them both at Saint Rose next weekend. I hope you will make every effort, along with your family members, to attend the 12 Noon Mass next weekend. We certainly want to impress upon our Bishop our support and prayers for all he has done and continues to do for the faithful of Northwest Ohio.

When the Bishop installs a pastor he has appointed to a parish, the protocol takes on a slightly different tone. First, the Bishop will be the main celebrant for the installation Mass. Msgr. Oxley, Fr. Kottana and I will concelebrate the Mass with Bishop Thomas, who will be assisted by our deacons. Just before the Entrance Procession into the church, the Bishop will greet the faithful from the church entrance and publically announce that he has entrusted to me, your pastor, the care of the parish in temporal and spiritual matters. Be sure to listen closely to the Bishop's exhortation to me at this beginning moment. The Opening Hymn for Mass is announced and the procession begins to the sanctuary. Mass will continue as it normally does with the Introductory Rites and Liturgy of the Word.

Once the Bishop has completed his homily, Msgr. Oxley, as Vicar for Clergy, stands before the people and reads the decree of my appointment as pastor of our parish. Then, I, standing before Bishop Thomas, am asked several questions that have the purpose of publically renewing my priestly promises made at ordination. The Bishop will invite me to lead the faithful in the Profession of Faith, which we all recite together. I will then continue to express a statement of my own pastoral responsibilities, my fidelity to the teachings of the Church and to those who guide and govern it. Placing my hand upon the Book of the Gospels, I will declare an Oath of Fidelity. Again, you will want to listen closely to the words I will speak as they express the responsibilities entrusted to a pastor of souls.

As a way of acknowledging the pastor's appointment, the Bishop publicly commends the pastor to the service of the people. Representatives of the parish staff and advisory councils come forward to greet the pastor. Mass then continues as we always experience it. As I relayed, it is an impressive ritual and one that I will certainly treasure in my mind and heart for a very long time. A reception will follow Noon Mass next Sunday in our school gymnasium. I hope you will plan to join us for food and fellowship.

Your kindnesses to me and your welcome to our parish these past days has made my transition very easy. There have been a number of times I have mentally said to myself that returning to Saint Rose after 22 years to serve as pastor is a dream come true. God has a way to offer us "home" and "family" in ways that cannot be explained. That is what we call God's "abundant grace." Keeping you and your intentions in my daily prayers.


