From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Parishioners of Saint Rose,

The passage of Issue 1 in the State of Ohio is certainly a saddening development. I know that many fellow Ohioans, especially

in our own local community, worked very hard these past weeks and months to change hearts and to provide a successful outcome to a most serious issue for our time. To those in our Saint Rose community that worked the front lines canvassing neighborhoods, making phone calls, placing yard signs, offering hours of prayer and acts of fasting that the constitutional amendment would not pass in the November 7 election, God will remember and his mercy will be upon you. As a pastor, I was inspired by the love and courageous conviction with which you approached this moral dilemma.

The morning after Tuesday's election, I came upon an internet posting from Protect Women Ohio, an organization that provided printed resources and information to defeat the passage of Issue 1. One segment of the press release after the passage was declared resonates well in my mind and heart in the aftermath: "We know that Issue 1 does not represent Ohio values. It took \$35 million in out-of-state funding and ads filled with fear and deceit to push through the most radical abortion agenda in the country. An agenda that will cement late-term abortions in our constitution, strip parents of their rights, and wipe out health and safety protections for women. This is not the Ohio way, and we are united in our fight against these extreme policies."

Sadly, according to many social media and political commentators, Ohio was the testing ground for the rest of the country. Pandora's Box, as they say, has been opened now and the battle really begins. In many respects, the silver lining of Tuesday's election will only bolster the motivation of the pro-life movement. The work and the effort is far from over. Just as the fifty-year challenge of Roe v. Wade was overturned, there will be peaceful and prayerful efforts that will increase now. God will never be outdone. The author and origin of LIFE will triumph in the end. God bless you this weekend.



Real Presence

There are many ways to make chicken cacciatore. I like mine with shredded chicken over white rice with some crusty bread and a bottle of good red wine.

But what does this have to do with the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist? This can be hard to understand and harder to explain. On one hand, it's easy to describe the color, smell, taste and the like of the Eucharist. That's all familiar to us because it still appears to be bread and wine. But what I'm finding difficult is describing its substance; what it is at its core.



Maybe this will help; after I make and eat that chicken cacciatore meal, my body will begin the process of changing all of it, including the bread and wine, into my body and blood. That complicated process is another of those things we don't think about. We just accept it as something that God designed. But we know the change does happen.

God took a more direct approach to changing His bread and wine, including that on the altar today, into His body and blood. He simply spoke it. Just as he spoke the world and everything in it into existence, He uses His priest, in the person of Jesus, to speak the bread and wine into His body and blood.

The next time you think about this, don't get caught up in how complicated it is or its appearance. Remember how He does it. He uses me to change my bread and wine into my body and blood, He uses His priest, speaking His words, to change His bread and wine into His body and blood. He speaks it into change. Then it really is His body and blood. His change happens, too!




