


INDEPENDENCE DAY

SACRAMENTS at ST. FRANCIS DE SALES

BAPTISM - *Birth to age 7:* Parents must be registered & attending Sunday Mass for at least 4 months, and are required to participate in a preparation class before the baptism. *Children between 7-14 years of age will participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children.*

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS: For adults and children age 15 and older. Classes begin in September each year.

MARRIAGE: Engaged couples should be practicing Catholics, participating regularly in Sunday Eucharist. At least six months' notice is required. Wedding date will not be set over the phone.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: upon request.

HOLY COMMUNION to the SICK/HOMEBOUND: Contact the Parish Office to request a visit.

PENANCE & RECONCILIATION: As scheduled in the weekly bulletin.

FIRST COMMUNION: For baptized children in the second grade, including those in Catholic school, required classes begin in September each year.

CONFIRMATION: For baptized children in the 9th grade who have previously completed 8th grade religious education, either in the parish or in Catholic school. Classes begin in September each year.

ARE YOU REGISTERED IN THE PARISH?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. ©LPI



Have you heard of the patron saint of purity? Born to peasant parents in southern Italy, St. Maria Goretti was a devout girl whose life was marked by difficulty. Her father died when she was nine, leaving her single mother with six mouths to feed. Two neighbors helped on the family farm, including a young man named Alessandro. He began making crude comments towards Maria. She repeatedly denied him. After several years, Alessandro attacked Maria to force himself on her. She resisted and, in his anger, Alessandro stabbed her. Maria died from the wounds' infections, but her last words were "I forgive Alessandro Serenelli, and I want him with me in heaven forever." While he was in prison, Maria appeared to Alessandro with a bouquet of roses, one for each wound he inflicted. In a true miracle of mercy, Alessandro experienced repentance, became a Franciscan brother after his release, and was later present at Maria's canonization. Her feast day is July 6. St. Maria Goretti, pray for us!


