### From the Desk of Msgr. Cincinnati

The month of August is geared to registration for Catechesis programs here at St. Francis de Sales. The **Parish Religious Education Program** (PREP) is the specialized program of formation for our children in kindergarten through the 8<sup>th</sup> grade who are not enrolled at St. Francis de Sales Central Catholic School. Additionally the Sacramental Programs for all our 2<sup>nd</sup> graders (Penance and Reconciliation / Holy Eucharist) and our high school students (Confirmation) are included. Parents and Guardians, please know it is <u>your</u> primary responsibility to see to it that your children are educated in the Faith. For this reason, please note there will be gatherings for you before the particular programs of Sacramental Preparation begin. The Parish is here to serve and assist you but we cannot replace the all-important role you promised to God to fulfil when your children were baptized.

The other major phase of catechetical instruction is **OCIA/OCIC** (formerly RCIA/RCIC) for those wishing to enhance their faith relationship with the Lord by means of learning more about the great sign and instrument of salvation in the world called the Church. All non-baptized and baptized individuals in other Christian denominations are welcome to participate. We welcome, too, family units for the faith journey, but children under 16 must be accompanied by at least one parent or guardian. Spread the word, tap on shoulders, and encourage spouses, relatives, friends and neighbors to consider learning more about the fullness of the Christian faith which is our rich and venerable Roman Catholic heritage. We would love to have you among our numbers! Please feel free to call the Parish Office for more details.

All formal classes of instruction begin on Sunday, 18 September 2022.



#### **ARE YOU REGISTERED IN THE PARISH?**

Registering in a parish is a declaration of your desire to be part of a Catholic community and to make a commitment to the life of the parish family.

Many people think that attendance in a parish means they automatically belong. *Membership requires completion of the Parish Registration form to be enrolled as a member of our parish.* 

Any adult children (over age 21) should fill out their own registration form, even if they still live in the family home. If your family is already registered and a child is over 21, please have them fill out a form. *Please notify the Parish Office of any address, phone, or email changes.* 

At St. Francis de Sales Parish, our policy states that you must be registered and regularly participating in Sunday Mass before a baptism may take place, or for the initial meeting with the pastor in the case of marriage.

To obtain a letter of Good Standing to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, regular attendance is also required.

- If your child completed 8th grade religious education class, he or she is eligible to register for the Confirmation class.




