
Marriage: Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least six months prior to the anticipated celebration.

At the Procession with Palms - Gospel Mk 11:1-10

When Jesus and his disciples drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately on entering it, you will find a colt tethered on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone should say to you, 'Why are you doing this?' reply, 'The Master has need of it and will send it back here at once." So they went off and found a colt tethered at a gate outside on the street, and they untied it. Some of the bystanders said to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" They answered them just as Jesus had told them to, and they permitted them to do it. So they brought the colt to Jesus and put their cloaks over it. And he sat on it. Many people spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut from the fields. Those preceding him as well as those following kept crying out: "Hosanna! From Fr. Dan....

With our celebration this weekend of Passion (Palm) Sunday, we begin the most solemn week of our church year and enter the final days of our Lenten season. Hopefully these past weeks since Ash Wednesday have been a rewarding time for you and, through the various practices of Lent, hopefully you've drawn closer to our Lord and experienced the presence of Christ in your life in some new or increasing way. There are still more opportunities in this final week to work on that relationship with Christ and to grow as His disciple.

▶ Between times at both of the churches of our parish, many people have already taken advantage of the opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Some people may have visited other parishes as well for that Sacrament. There are two remaining opportunities in our parish before Easter: on Monday, March 29, at St. Joan of Arc Church, from 6—8 PM; and on Tuesday, March 30, at St. Louise de Marillac Church, from 6:30—7:30 PM. After those times, there will be no further scheduled times for Confession here in St. Catherine Labouré Parish before Easter, although Confessions can be heard by appointment.

PLEASE NOTE: THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE AT THE USUAL SATURDAY TIMES AT EITHER CHURCH, ON HOLY SATURDAY, APRIL 3.

▶ On Holy Thursday (April 1) there are no morning Masses at either Church. The only Masses that day will be at 7 PM, and we will have two Masses at that time, one at St. Joan of Arc and one at St. Louise de Marillac. On this occasion, we celebrate that night when Jesus instituted the Eucharist, giving his disciples his Body and Blood for the first time; AND instituted the priesthood, by instructing those chosen ones to "Do this in memory of me"! This is the last Mass we celebrate until the Easter Vigil. Following this Mass the Blessed Sacrament will be removed from the altar and tabernacle and placed in a separate "altar of repose" in each church.

Both St. Joan of Arc Church and St. Louise de Marillac Church will remain open until 11 PM. This is for those who wish to spend some time in prayer with our Lord on this holy night.

- ▶ On Good Friday (April 2), in BOTH of our churches, we will recall the Lord's Passion, beginning at 1:30 PM. We will read the gospel account of the passion of the Lord, we will pray, collectively venerate the Cross (Due to Covid safety considerations, for this year, we will not have individual veneration of the Cross. It would not be safe for everyone to kiss or touch the same Cross). At this liturgy, we will also have an opportunity to receive Holy Communion (there is no Mass, but we will use the Eucharist that was consecrated on Holy Thursday).
- ► ALSO, On Good Friday (April 2), in BOTH of our churches, we will pray the Stations of the Cross.

 > before the afternoon liturgy, at Noon, at St. Louise de Marillac Church

 > and at BOTH churches that evening at 7 PM.
- ▶ On the morning of Holy Saturday (April 3), at 11 AM, in BOTH churches, there will be the blessing of Easter food in the Church.

PLEASE BE AWARE: To protect against over crowding, for the safety of those who wish to come, we will be observing limitations on the number of people who may attend our Easter Masses. Thus, we will be using a reservation system for ALL seating areas (i.e. the churches, the Gathering Place and the gym). This will not only help to allow for safe limits, but also provides the convenience of knowing before you come to church whether or not there is space available. Reservations can be made through the parish website (SCLPGH.ORG) or by calling the parish office. ALL THE MASSES WILL BE LIVED STREAMED through VIMEO (with links on our website). Select Masses will be available through Facebook (see the website for details).

- ▶ On Holy Saturday, all will be quiet in the church during the day, until the glorious celebration of our Easter Vigil (beginning after sunset, at 8:30 PM, April 3). This beautiful liturgy is the most solemn Mass of our liturgical year. We will begin outside by lighting our new fire and process into church with candles for an extended Liturgy of the Word. Following the Homily, we will celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation for the new members of our Catholic faith. This liturgy is a very powerful and beautiful one. (Be aware, if you haven't attended the Easter Vigil before, and especially if you have young children, this celebration is about 2 hours in length).
- ► For the glorious celebration of Easter Sunday the schedule will be the same at St. Joan and St. Louise. We will have Masses at 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM and Noon.
 - > At St. Joan, The Gathering Place will be used for additional seating.
 - > At St. Louise, at 10 AM and Noon, we will have a 2nd Mass taking place in the school gym.

Please note, for those uncomfortable coming to the more crowded Easter Sunday celebrations, that each day of Easter Week all of our Masses are celebrated as Easter Sunday

Thus, providing many additional opportunities to attend Mass in a less crowded environment.

We understand that change can be difficult but believe that OSV will be a dependable partner and provide an overall cost savings to Saint Catherine Labouré.

You can access the online giving site by either going to the parish website at www.sja-stl.org click on either Give to Saint Joan or Give to Saint Louise de Marillac, under the Electronic Giving click on the Click Here button and follow the instruction. Or you may go directly to the site using https://osvhub.com/st-louise-de-marillac-church/funds.

Couple of things to note: Donations can be scheduled weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, or quarterly or you can choice a specific date (example 4th of each month). The monthly donations will be taken on the 1st of each month. When signing up, you can make your offertory and second collection donations at the same time and not need to worry the rest of the year. For second collections, simply click on the collection button, select a date (the comment section indicates the month of the collection), select one time gift and dollar amount.

CHOOSING GODPARENTS

From time to time questions and controversies arise as to who may serve as a Godparent for the Sacrament of Baptism. Therefore, this is a review of the guidelines established by the Catholic Church concerning Godparent eligibility. These regulations should be considered before the parents of a child ask someone to be a Godparent for their son or daughter:

- ♦ The decision as to who should be a Godparent should be based upon who would provide the best example of Catholic living for the child and not merely for reasons of maintaining family harmony. A Godparent is chosen not primarily to honor the Godparent, but for the well-being and faith development of the child.
- ◆In order to be a Godparent for Baptism, an individual must be a practicing Catholic, at least 16 years of age and have received the Sacraments of Initiation (i.e. Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation). 'Furthermore, if this person is married, then the marriage must be a valid, sacramental marriage (i.e. one recognized and blessed by the Catholic Church).
- ◆The potential Godparent must be registered in a Catholic parish and able to obtain from his or her parish priest a letter of eligibility to be a Godparent.
- •Only one Godparent is required by Church law. This Godparent may be a man or a woman. However, if two Godparents are selected (the more common practice), then there must be one man and one woman chosen. In other words, a child cannot have two men or two women as Godparents.
- ♦ In extraordinary situations when two Catholic Godparents cannot be found, then a baptized person who belongs to another Christian denomination (e.g. Methodist, Lutheran, or Presbyterian) may serve as a Christian Witness. However, former Catholics who have left the Catholic Church for another Christian denomination are not permitted to serve as Christian Witnesses.

Since Baptism is the initial, foundational Sacrament in the life of a Catholic, great care must be taken in deciding who will serve as a Godparent. The guidelines above are meant to assist parents in making a reasonable and secure decision as to who will fulfill this critical role for their child. Since they are provided by the universal Church and individual priests are not vested with the authority to dispense from them, these guidelines will be strictly followed.




